Subject: Notice of Federal Grant Opportunity – Basic Needs for Postsecondary Students

Program

The Office of Postsecondary Education at the U.S. Department of Education announced a new grant opportunity for the Basic Needs for Postsecondary Students Program. The program provides grants to eligible institutions of higher education to do the following:

- 1) Advance systemic and sustainable solutions to student basic needs insecurity through support programs that address the basic needs of students; and
- 2) Report on practices that improve outcomes for students.

The deadline to submit applications is **August 5**, 2024.
