In 2007, College Bound served
2770 students in 210 public
middle and high schools in
16 Abbott districts.





- → The college enrollment rate was 73% for College Bound students in 2007. From 2004-2006, the average college enrollment rate for College Bound students was 71%, compared to 37%, the statewide average for low income students.
- → The 2007 college enrollment rate for African American and Hispanic College Bound students was 73% and 68% respectively.

Average Verbal SAT score <sup>2</sup>	430	393 at target high schools
Average Math SAT score <sup>2</sup>	450	405 at target high schools
Average Writing SAT Score	431	388 at target high schools
