SUBJECT: Recent Closure of ITT Technical Institute's Marlton, NJ Campus

As you are aware, ITT Technical Institute announced on September 6, 2016 that it would cease operations at its main campuses and 134 branch campuses, including the campus in Marlton, NJ. In order to minimize the impact of the closure on New Jersey students enrolled at the Marlton campus, please note the following:

- 1. The U.S. Department of Education has established a website for former ITT students, which has information on how former ITT students can continue their education, apply for closed school loan discharges, retrieve student records, and more, at https://studentaid.ed.gov/sa/about/announcements/itt.
- 2. ITT Technical Institute transcripts can be ordered from Parchment at http://www.parchment.com/ITT/.
- 3. Former ITT students that are interested in applying to a New Jersey institution in order to continue their education can consult the "Inventory of Degree and Certificate Program Offerings at New Jersey Institutions of Higher Education" (http://www.nj.gov/highereducation/Program Inventory/index.shtml) to obtain information about the various degrees offered by New Jersey institutions of higher education.
- 4. Former ITT students may be able to obtain college credit through the New Jersey Prior Learning Assessment Network (NJ PLAN), which is a consortium of New Jersey colleges and universities partnering to provide the opportunity for their students to earn credit toward their degrees through Prior Learning Assessment (PLA). - 5. OSHE has been contacted by Hussian College, located in Philadelphia, PA, which advised OSHE that former ITT students from the Computer Drafting and Design program may be able to obtain transfer credit in Hussian College's Bachelor of Fine Art (BFA) program, which offers a concentration in Digital Media, Graphic Design, and Visual Communication.
