¹ Invited by NJ public school districts to offer dual credit courses at 36 different high schools. All NJ Syracuse students are high school students enrolled in dual credit courses. Syracuse has been offering dual-credit courses in NJ since 1976 (43 years). Accordingly, the Office of the Secretary of Higher Education (OSHE) does not require a consultant review and report for each year Syracuse seeks to add courses or locations. To do so annually would be redundant, as the review is in large part an institutional one and institutions do not typically change significantly on an annual basis, as well as a waste of OSHE's limited capacity to conduct licensure reviews.

ii Enrollment for Nova Southeastern University's licensed program/sites was zero (no students). The university is currently evaluating development opportunities for the program.

iii Syracuse University submitted enrollment data as part of their New Jersey 5 year plan and relicensure application. These numbers are also projections based on the report provided and expected to stay consistent.

iv Due to COVID, Wilmington University transitioned all their courses to online instruction, including those involving the New Jersey Locations.
