VF/EA Fiscal Intermediary Transition

- All individuals who have an active vendor service and/or a self-directed employee (SDE) with PPL as the fiscal intermediary (FI) must enroll with Acumen now.
 - This includes Employers of Record, SDEs, and Vendors currently with PPL.
- Delaying Acumen enrollment may result in an interruption in services, missed payments, or both.

EVV and Service Documentation Webinars – Nov. and Dec. 2025 For Individuals/Families, Employers of Record, and Self-Directed Employees

- All self-directed employees (SDE) are required to maintain service documentation, regardless of living arrangement or relationship to the employer or to the individual receiving services.
- SDE payment processing will not move forward for any pay-period in which there are time entries that do not include service documentation.



Housing Subsidy Update

- The FY26 budget included a \$1M funding reduction for DDD Housing Subsidies.
- This reduction impacts the ability to assign <u>new</u> housing subsidies to individuals enrolled on the Supports Program.
- At this time, individuals who receive services from the Community Care Program are not expected to be impacted.
- DDD will continue to monitor subsidy availability and provide updates accordingly.

New Support Coordination Competency Requirements

- In collaboration with Money Follows the Person (MFP) Support Coordination (SC) Competency and Capacity Stakeholder Committee, DDD has established new SC competency priorities and training requirements.

A month to focus on supervision, independence, and how to keep IDD individuals safe

■ Why have Safety In Your Setting Month?

Individuals with IDD can be at risk if proper supervision is not provided. Due to this, specific training sessions have been selected that relate to individuals who exhibit walkaway behavior. The Division's hope is to educate stakeholders, highlight prevention strategies, and empower providers and Support Coordination Agency (SCA) staff to keep IDD individuals safe, while still allowing them to experience the independence they deserve both in their homes, and in the community.

■ Round Table Discussion (invite only)

Select residential and behavior support providers, as well as SCAs will be invited to join a collaborative group discussion with DDD and DHS staff. The goal is for agencies to share best practices relating to walkaway events, and have a constructive dialogue regarding supervision, safety, and documentation.

■ Virtual Trainings

Virtual workshops will be held throughout November. The Division welcomes all stakeholders to attend, including: providers, SCAs, Self Directed Employees, family members, and advocates.

- Seasonal Health Concerns: Cold Weather


