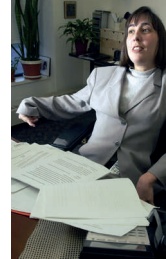

Now you can achieve even more

If you're someone with a permanent disability, you're used to overcoming obstacles. With *NJ WorkAbility*, you've got one less hurdle to clear. You're free to go for that job, aim for that raise, and get your career in gear without having to worry about losing your Medicaid coverage.



Earn approximately \$65,000 annually

With *NJ WorkAbility*, you can earn as much as *\$65,196 per year and still be fully eligible for NJ FamilyCare (Medicaid). You can also have up to \$20,000 in

liquid assets, such as bank accounts, and still qualify. When calculating assets, the following are not included:

- primary residence
- vehicles used for medical transportation
- vehicles used for transportation to and from work
- IRA and 401K personal retirement accounts
- a NJ ABLE account

And keep the health benefits you need most

NJ WorkAbility is a program that expands Medicaid eligibility so that employed individuals with disabilities can earn a living and still qualify for the necessary Medicaid benefits that support their ability to work.

Coverage includes:

- medications
- durable medical equipment
- personal care assistant services
- medical transportation
- medical and healthcare services

Because *NJ WorkAbility* is a permanent state and federally funded program, you can depend on it. As long as you remain eligible, you will not lose your benefits.

Who is eligible?

NJ WorkAbility is available to New Jersey residents who have a permanent disability as determined by the Social Security Administration and meet the following criteria:

- aged 16 through 64
- employed, with proof of employment
- have **earned** income equal to or less than:
 - *\$65,196 per year/\$5,433 per month for an individual
 - *\$87,900 per year /\$7,325 per month for a couple – both disabled & employed
- have **unearned** income equal to or less than
 - \$1,074 per month for an individual
 - \$1,452 per month for a couple - both disabled & employed
- have liquid **assets** less than
 - \$20,000 for an individual
 - \$30,000 for an eligible couple.

All figures reflect year 2021

**NOTE: If you have unearned income in addition to earnings, the maximum earned income threshold will vary*
