

Notice of Funding Opportunity

The County of Mercer is soliciting proposals through the competitive contracting process in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.1, et seq.

The Mercer County Department of Human Services, Office on Aging/Aging and Disability Resource Connection (ADRC), is accepting proposals for the period of January 1, 2025, through December 31, 2026, to provide Peer Grouping and County Direct Funding in the amount of \$608,920.00.

Funding will be made available in the following service categories:

- Youth Respite Services
- Occupational Training
- Recreational Opportunities & The Summer Camp Scholarship Program
- Adult Day Services
- Sports & Athletics Opportunities
- The Institute for the Arts Program
- Durable Medical Equipment Recycling and Distribution
- Care Management for Older Adults

This funding is to provide services and programs for Mercer County older adults age 60 and older, and/or Mercer County residents who have a physical or developmental disability, as described within each specific program. Priorities of this office will ensure that services assist older individuals with greatest social and economic needs, as well as minorities, older individuals at risk of institutional placement, older individuals residing in rural areas, older individuals with Alzheimer's disease and related disorders, caregivers of older individuals with Alzheimer's disease and related disorders, and residents with severe disabilities.
