Petitioner appeals the Respondent Agency's determination to place Petitioner at a particular shelter. Because Petitioner appealed, the matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for a hearing. A hearing was initially scheduled for July 2, 2020, before the Honorable Evelyn J. Marose, Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ"). In the course of that hearing, it was determined that the Agency needed to investigate some claims made by Petitioner. The hearing then continued on July 7, 2020, at which time the matter concluded and the record then closed.

On July 9, 2020, the ALJ issued an Initial Decision, dismissing Petitioner's appeal. The record in this matter reflects that Petitioner is presently receiving Emergency Assistance ("EA") benefits. See Initial Decision at 2. The record further shows that Petitioner was moved from a prior placement at the Village Hotel, where Petitioner had resided for approximately two years, to his present placement, following an altercation amongst several residents at the Village Hotel. Ibid. Through the present appeal, Petitioner seeks to be placed back at the Village Hotel. Ibid. However, in light of the fact that Petitioner is not presently homeless, or imminently homeless, the ALJ dismissed Petitioner's appeal. Id. at 3. I agree, and further note that it is the Agency that determines the appropriate placement. See N.J.A.C. 10:90-6.3(a)(1).

No Exceptions to the Initial Decision were received.

As Assistant Commissioner, Division of Family Development, Department of Human Services, I have reviewed the ALJ's Initial Decision and the record, and I hereby ADOPT the ALJ's Initial Decision, and dismiss Petitioner's appeal in this matter.

Accordingly, the Initial Decision is hereby ADOPTED, and Petitioner's appeal is DISMISSED.
