FINAL DECISION

Petitioner appeals from the Respondent Agency's termination of Emergency Assistance ("EA") benefits. The Agency terminated Petitioner's EA benefits, contending that Petitioner had failed to locate affordable housing within 60 days, and failed to provide proof of required housing searches, in violation of his EA service plan ("SP"). Because Petitioner appealed, the matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law for a hearing. On June 29, 2020, the Honorable Sarah G. Crowley, Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ"), held a telephonic plenary hearing, took testimony and admitted documents. The record remained open until June 30, 2020, to allow Petitioner twenty-four hours to submit additional documentation demonstrating proof of housing searches, and then closed. On July 8, 2020, the ALJ issued an Initial Decision, affirming the Agency's termination of Petitioner's EA benefits.

This office has been advised that the Agency is rescinding its termination of Petitioner's EA benefits. Therefore, as Assistant Commissioner, Division of Family Development, Department of Human Services, I find that, as a contested case no longer exists, this matter has now been rendered moot, and as such, I hereby DISMISS Petitioner's appeal.

Accordingly, as no contested case exists in this matter, Petitioner's appeal is hereby DISMISSED.
