FINAL AGENCY DECISION

OAL DKT. NO. HMA 19115-16

As Director of the Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services, I have reviewed the record in this case, including the Initial Decision and the Settlement Agreement. Procedurally, the time period for the Agency Head to file a Final Agency Decision in this matter is March 13, 2017 in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-10 which requires an Agency Head to adopt, reject, or modify the Initial Decision within 45 days of receipt. The Initial Decision was received on January 25, 2017.

This matter concerns the denial of Petitioner's eligibility for Medicaid benefits. However, by Settlement Agreement filed with the Office of Administrative Law, the


parties agreed to amicably resolve this controversy wherein Hudson County agreed to review the income verifications submitted by Petitioner at the January 17, 2017 Office of Administrative Law hearing. The Administrative Law Judge approved the Settlement Agreement because it was consistent with the law, fully disposed of all issues in controversy and was voluntarily entered into by both parties, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 1:1-19.1.

Based on my review of the record, I concur with the ALJ's findings and hereby ADOPT the Settlement Agreement.

THEREFORE, it is on this ^{15th} day of MARCH 2017,

ORDERED:

That the Initial Decision approving the Settlement Agreement is hereby ADOPTED.
