


This matter arises from the termination of Petitioner A.S.G.'s Medicaid benefits by Respondent Hudson County because of Petitioner's excess resources. On the scheduled hearing date, the parties agreed to settle the matter. Hudson County reevaluated Petitioner's eligibility for benefits, found that Petitioner was eligible and agreed to reinstate Petitioner's Medicaid benefits effective January 1, 2019. By Initial Decision dated February 7, 2019, the ALJ approved the Settlement Agreement because it was consistent with the law, fully disposed of all issues in controversy and was voluntarily entered into by both parties in accordance with N.J.A.C. 1:11-19.1.

Based on my review of the record, I concur with the ALJ's findings and hereby ADOPT the Settlement Agreement.

THEREFORE, it is on this ^{26th} day of MARCH 2019,

ORDERED:

That the Initial Decision affirming the Settlement Agreement in this matter is hereby ADOPTED.
