As Director of the Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services, I have reviewed the record in this case, including the OAL case file and the Initial Decision approving the Settlement Agreement reached by the parties. Procedurally, the time period for the Agency Head to file a Final Decision is August 12, 2019, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-10 which requires an Agency Head to adopt, reject, or modify the Initial Decision within 45 days of receipt. The Initial Decision was received on June 27, 2019.

This matter arises from Essex County Department of Citizen Services' denial of Petitioner's eligibility for MLTSS based on Petitioner's resources exceeding eligibility limits. On the date of the fair hearing the parties mutually agreed that Petitioner will reapply and
