

not useful to a beneficiary in the absence of a disease, illness, injury, or disability; and is capable of withstanding repeated use (durable) and is nonexpendable. N.J.A.C. 10:59-1.2. In light of Petitioner's testimony, there must be some analysis or explanation as to why the requested DME is not medically necessary under these particular circumstances. While Petitioner's testimony, unsupported by any medical documentation, is not sufficient to establish a medical need, his claims should be reviewed and addressed by Horizon.

For these reasons, I am REVERSING the Initial Decision and RETURNING the matter to Horizon to review Petitioner's request and issue a new determination within thirty days.

THEREFORE, it is on this ^{18th} day of OCTOBER 2021,

ORDERED:

That the Initial Decision is hereby REVERSED and RETURNED to Horizon.
