STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Respondent denied petitioner's Medicaid Only application for failure to provide the following evidence of eligibility under N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.2(e):

Information regarding Hancock policy, Sun Life checks, and Medicare reimbursements from employer (Verizon), and other checks as set out in Request For Information dated October 30, 2024.

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
