STATEMENT OF THE CASE
Respondent denied petitioner's Medicaid Only application for failure to provide the following evidence of eligibility under N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.2(e):
Petitioner failed to supply corroborating evidence necessary to determine eligibility at
the time of application and in letter dated May 7, 2024. Petitioner failed to send any
response. Specifically, petitioner failed to verify sixty months of quarterly bank
statements; explanation for transactions over \$1,000; facility admission form
LTC-2; and other requested documents.

# FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

I.

I FIND that petitioner or petitioner's representative is AUTHORIZED to pursue this appeal; therefore, I CONCLUDE that standing is established.
I FIND that petitioner or petitioner's representative is NOT AUTHORIZED to pursue this appeal; therefore, I CONCLUDE that standing is not been established.
II.
I FIND that petitioner did not timely provide all the required documentation under N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.2(e) and -2.3(a), and that no exceptional circumstances exist under N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.3(c); therefore, I CONCLUDE that the Medicaid Only application must be <b>DENIED</b> under N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.2(e).
I <b>FIND</b> that petitioner did not timely provide all the required documentation under N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.2(e) and -2.3(a), but that exceptional circumstances exist under N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.3(c); therefore, I <b>CONCLUDE</b> that the time limit for verification must be <b>EXTENDED</b> under N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.3(c).
I FIND that petitioner did not timely provide all the required documentation under N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.2(e) and -2.3(a); exceptional circumstances exist under N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.3(c); and petitioner has since provided all the required documentation; therefore, I CONCLUDE that the Medicaid Only application must be PROCESSED to determine eligibility under N.J.A.C. 10:71.
I FIND that petitioner timely provided all the required documentation under N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.2(e) and -2.3(a); therefore, I CONCLUDE that the Medicaid Only application must be PROCESSED to determine eligibility under N.J.A.C. 10:71.
ADDITIONAL FINDINGS OF FACT/CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
An REI letter was mailed to the notitioner with a due date of May 24, 2004
An RFI letter was mailed to the petitioner with a due date of May 21, 2024.
Petitioner did not respond. Petitioner's assertion that the RFI was not received
was not proven. The DAR who worked on the case for petitioner no longer works for
Future Care Consultants, and was not present. The DAR's supervisor testified instead.
The agency failed to inform petitioner of its delay in processing the application.
N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.3(d). Its failure was not sufficient under these facts to return the
application to the agency for processing.

Petitioner's appeal is <b>DISMISSED</b> becaus	e petitioner has no standing.
Petitioner is INELIGIBLE for Medicaid Only	y under N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.2(e).
Respondent must EXTEND the time limit f	or verification under N.J.A.C. 10:71-2.3(c).
The case be <b>RETURNED</b> to respondent for to determine eligibility under N.J.A.C. 10:7	r respondent to <b>PROCESS</b> the application 1.
