Training is open to anyone who is at risk of an opioid overdose or their family and friends. All participants will receive a treatment voucher for 30 days of free substance abuse treatment, at JSAS Healthcare, Inc., to use or distribute to any person that needs medication-assisted treatment (methadone). In addition, education will be provided on how to administer naloxone to reverse a heroin/opioid overdose.
