**Name of Program:** To Provide Supportive Housing Services for Mental Health Consumers At Risk of Hospitalization and Homelessness

**Purpose:** The Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS) has made the following awards for the provision of Community Support Services (CSS) to adult consumers age 18 and over being discharged from a New Jersey State Psychiatric Hospital and who are at risk of re-hospitalization and homelessness.

The annualized total funding is \$312,500 subject to State appropriations. The DMHAS will initiate a deficit funded contract for a period of six (6) months, after which the contract will be transitioned into the fee for service network, subject to state appropriations. DMHAS anticipates serving a *minimum* of 25 individuals.
