Name of Program: Bi-Lingual / Bi-Cultural Outpatient Clinician

Purpose: The DMHAS has made one award to recruit and retain one (1) FTE licensed bi-lingual, bi-cultural mental health clinician to provide care, treatment and bi-lingual/multicultural services to adult consumers of mental health services in Hudson County. Funding is intended to support increased recruitment and retention of culturally competent staff, at community-based multicultural mental health agencies. The funded agency will foster access to culturally competent and linguistically appropriate mental health services. The resources available in the current initiative are not a new appropriation to the DMHAS; rather it is the re-bidding of an existing resource.
