Name of Program: Recovery Housing and Supports on College Campuses

Purpose:

This Request for Proposals (RFP) is for funding for supportive, substance-free living environments and services for college students in recovery. Each college or university awardee will be required to provide individual and group substance abuse recovery-oriented programs and services, implement environmental prevention strategies, provide assessment, academic, and personal counseling services to students, and other appropriate services. Note that designated recovery housing may include a dorm, floor, wing or other area within an existing residential building or other student housing and does not require that an entire dormitory be substance-free.

DMHAS made four awards to two- and four-year public institutions of higher education to provide recovery housing and/or recovery support services. Funding awarded through this RFP is \$668,520 subject to federal appropriations. This RFP is funded through the federal Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration’s (SAMHSA) State Opioid Response (SOR) grant supplemental funding. The SOR grant period is September 30, 2018 to September 29, 2020. The funding available is one-time only and not renewable.
