Name of Program: Implementation of Evidence Based Practices for First Episode Psychosis (RFP)

Purpose: The Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS) in collaboration with the Department of Children and Families (DCF), Division of Children's System of Care (CSOC), has made 3 awards for implementing a Coordinated Specialty Care (CSC) for First Episode Psychosis (FEP) model in New Jersey to provide services to identify, intervene in and treat FEP. One team will cover counties in the northern part of New Jersey. Another team will cover counties in the central part of New Jersey and the third team will cover counties in the southern part of New Jersey. Regions are defined as follows: Northern region includes Bergen, Essex, Hudson, Hunterdon, Morris, Passaic, Somerset, Sussex, Union and Warren counties; Central Region includes Mercer, Middlesex and Monmouth counties; Southern Region includes Atlantic, Burlington, Camden, Cape May, Cumberland, Gloucester, Ocean and Salem. Funding is available for one year with the possibility of renewal annually.
