Opioid Overdose Prevention Program (OOPP)

Name of Program: Opioid Overdose Prevention Program (OOPP)

Purpose: This Request for Proposals (RFP) sought to establish a statewide opioid overdose prevention program to include an educational component, outreach to at-risk individuals, collaboration with interested stakeholders and distribution of naloxone rescue kits. The program will provide education to individuals at risk for an opioid overdose, their families, friends and loved ones to recognize an opiate overdose and to subsequently provide life-saving rescue measures to reverse the effects of an opioid overdose.

DMHAS and the Governor’s Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse (GCADA) will provide total annualized funding in the amount of \$675,000, which will be available for two (2) years. Three (3) regionalized contracts in the amount of \$225,000 were awarded for each of the following regions:

North: Bergen, Essex, Hudson, Morris, Passaic, Sussex and Warren Counties
Central: Hunterdon, Mercer, Middlesex, Monmouth, Somerset and Union Counties
South: Atlantic, Burlington, Camden, Cape May, Cumberland, Gloucester, Ocean and Salem Counties.
