Opioid Overdose Recovery Program

Name of Program: Opioid Overdose Recovery Program

Purpose: This Request for Proposals (RFP) sought to develop an Opioid Overdose Recovery Program (OORP) to respond to individuals reversed from opioid overdoses and treated at hospital emergency departments as a result of the reversal. The Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services (DMHAS), the Governor’s Council on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse (GCADA) and the Department of Children and Families (DCF) will provide total annualized funding of \$255,750 for two (2) years. One (1) contract was awarded in Passaic County.

OORP will utilize Recovery Specialists and Patient Navigators to engage individuals reversed from an opioid overdose to provide non-clinical assistance, recovery supports and appropriate referrals for assessment and substance use disorder treatment. The Recovery Specialists and Patient Navigators will also maintain follow-up with these individuals. It is planned that, at minimum, recovery specialists will be accessible and on-call from Thursday evenings through Monday mornings.
