Name of Program: Adult Psychiatry Residency and Child/Adolescent Psychiatry Fellowship Training

Purpose: For the last four years, DHS/DMHAS has been using state funding to support additional residency positions in the accredited adult psychiatry residency programs and child and adolescent psychiatry fellowships in New Jersey. The initiatives are addressing the shortage of psychiatrists and child psychiatrists in the state. In addition to increasing the number of psychiatry residency and Fellowship positions, the program is designed to provide residents and fellows with extensive experience in the community and public behavioral health system, including settings that serve individuals in the community who have serious mental illness, substance use disorders, or intellectual /developmental disabilities. The initiative encourages recruitment of qualified candidates for residency and fellowship training who are likely to practice psychiatry in the state after graduation. The programs receive supplemental funding to support faculty to provide supervision and mentorship of the psychiatry residents and fellows. The residency and fellowship program classes commence on July 1 of each year and end on June 30. Since its inception, the state funding has supported a total of 64 four-year adult psychiatry residency positions and 5 two-year Child and Adolescent fellowship positions. The Tables indicate the numbers of positions supported over the last four years.

A. On July 1, 2025 the following number of 4 Year Adult Psychiatry Residency residents will start:

- (1) 17 will start Post Grad Year 1**
- (2) 19 who started July 2024 will start Post Grad Year 2**
- (3) 18 who started July 2023 will start Post Grad Year 3**
- (4) 10 who started July 2022 will start Post Grad Year 4**

TOTAL ENROLLED ADULT PSYCHIATRY RESIDENCY = 64

B. On July 1, 2025 the following number of 2 Year Child/Adolescent Psychiatry Fellowship Training fellows will start:

- (1) 2 Fellows will start their CAP Fellowship Year 1**
- (2) 3 Fellows who started July 2024 will start their CAP Fellowship Year 2**

C. June 2025, 4 fellows will graduate from the Child/Adolescent Psychiatry Fellowship training.
