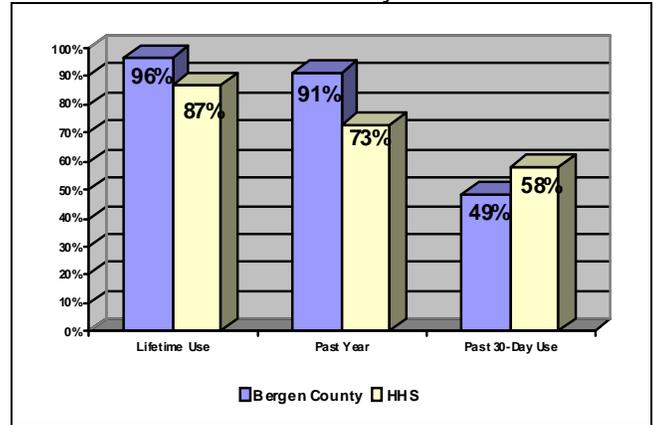

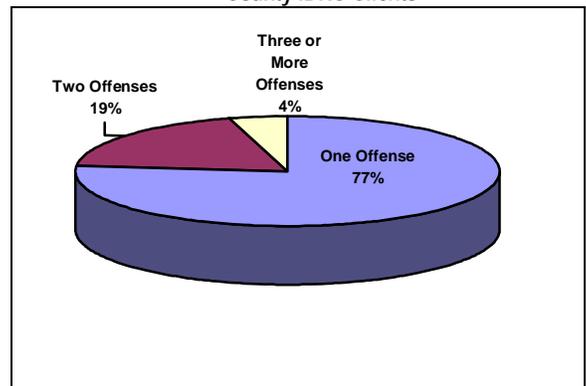

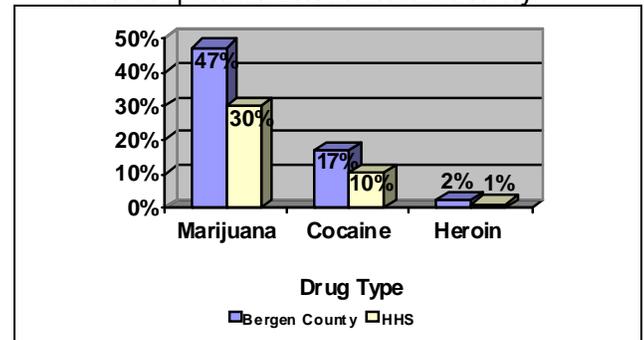
**Alcohol Use by Bergen County IDRC Clients Compared with 2003 NJ Household Survey**



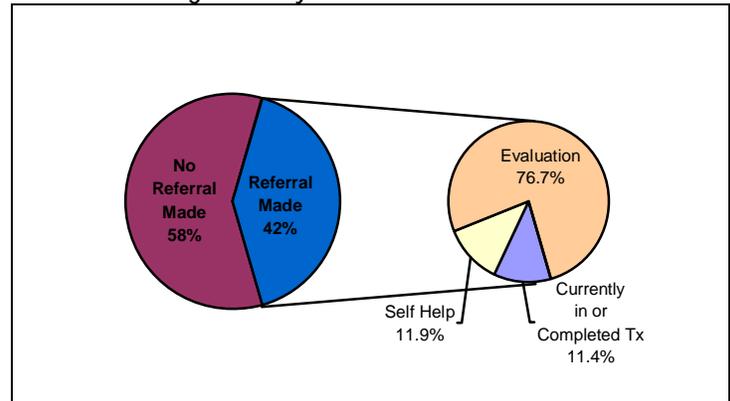
**Number of Alcohol-Related Offenses on DMV Records of Bergen County IDRC Clients**

**2008 Bergen County Resident Referrals from IDRC**



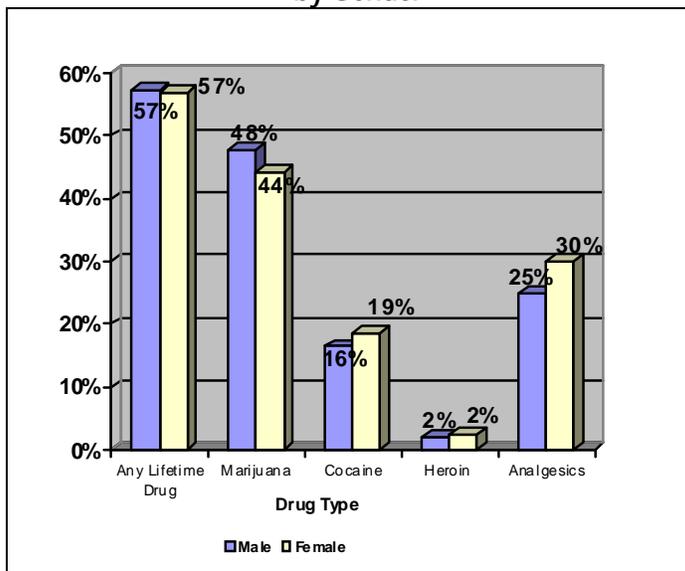
