


Data were collected on 525 clients who went through the Sussex County Intoxicated Driver Resource Center in 2009 or were monitored by the Sussex County IDRC. 


Alcohol Use by Sussex County IDRC Clients Compared with 2003 NJ Household Survey




Number of Alcohol-Related Offenses on DMV Records of Sussex County IDRC Clients

2009 Sussex County Resident Referrals from IDRC




