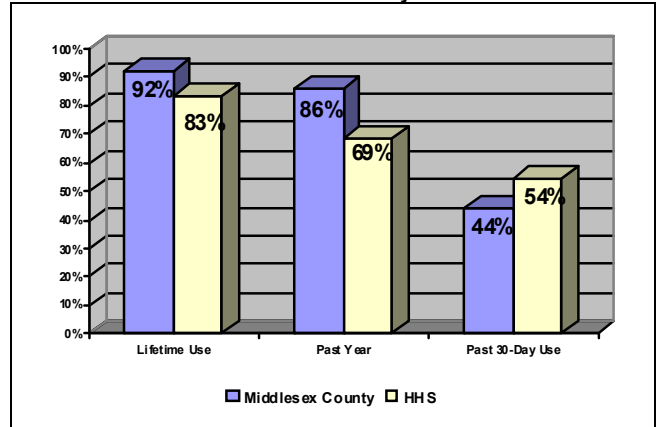


Data were collected on 1638 clients in 2010 who went through the Middlesex County Intoxicated Driver Resource Center program or were monitored by the Middlesex County IDRC. 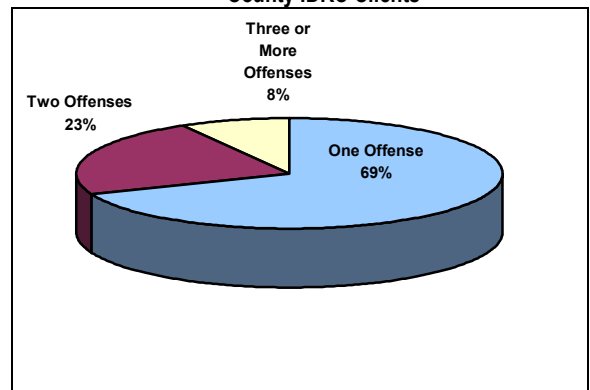

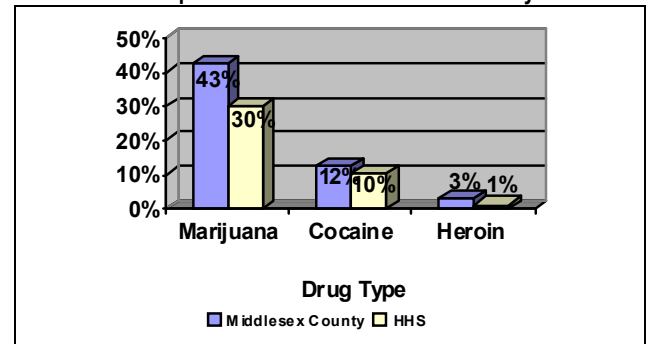
Alcohol Use by Middlesex County IDRC Clients Compared with 2009 NJ Household Survey



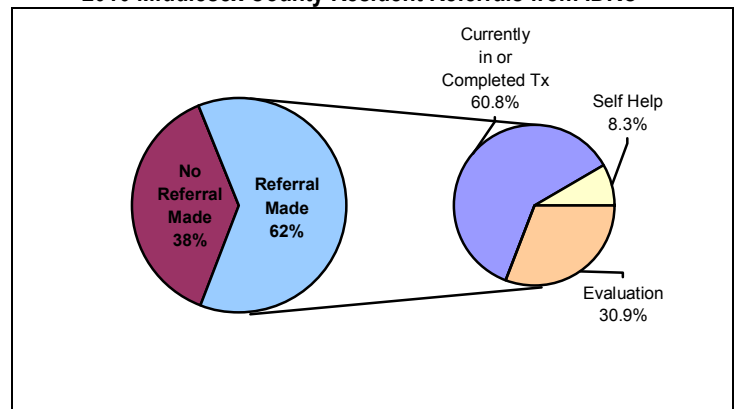
Number of Alcohol-Related Offenses on DMV Records of Middlesex County IDRC Clients

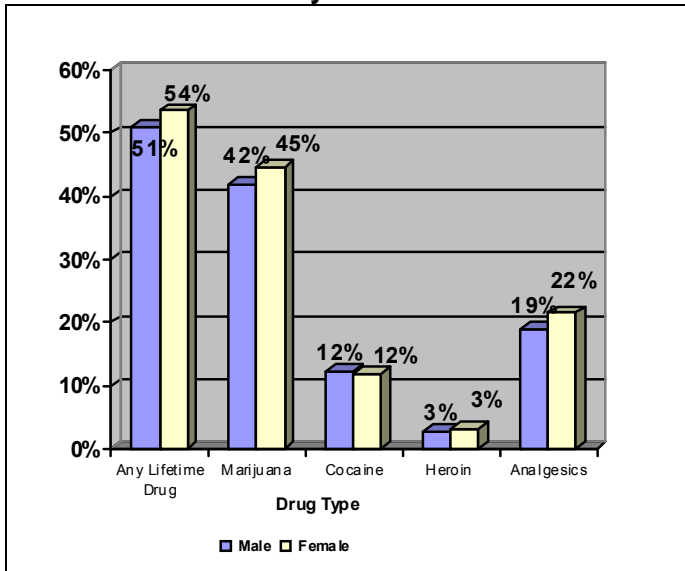
