


Data were collected on 535 clients in 2010 who went through the Sussex County Intoxicated Driver Resource Center program or were monitored by the Sussex County IDRC. Information was gathered from a mandatory self-administered questionnaire given during the IDRC classes and the counselors' screening/evaluation scoring forms.




**Alcohol Use by Sussex County IDRC Clients Compared with 2009 NJ Household Survey**




**Number of Alcohol-Related Offenses on DMV Records of Sussex County IDRC Clients**


