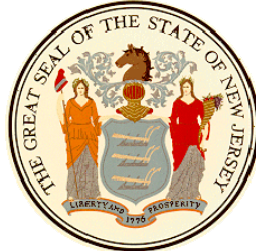

This *Substance Abuse Overview* provides statistics on substance abuse treatment in each New Jersey county for calendar year 2010. In 2010 there were 71,874 treatment admissions and 70,594 discharges reported to the New Jersey Department of Human Services, Division of Addiction Services by substance abuse treatment providers. 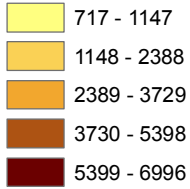

2010 Substance Abuse Admissions by County of Residence

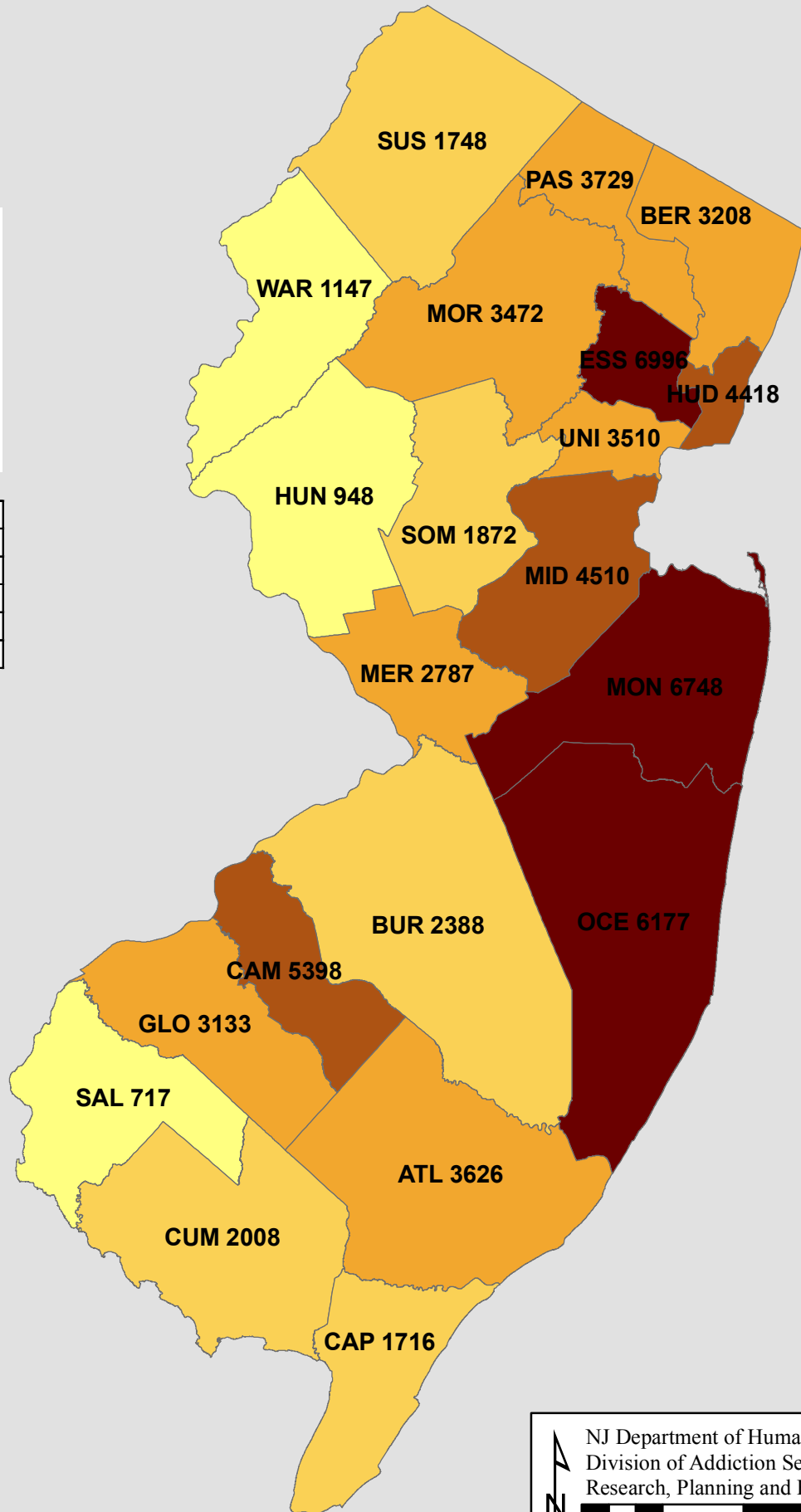

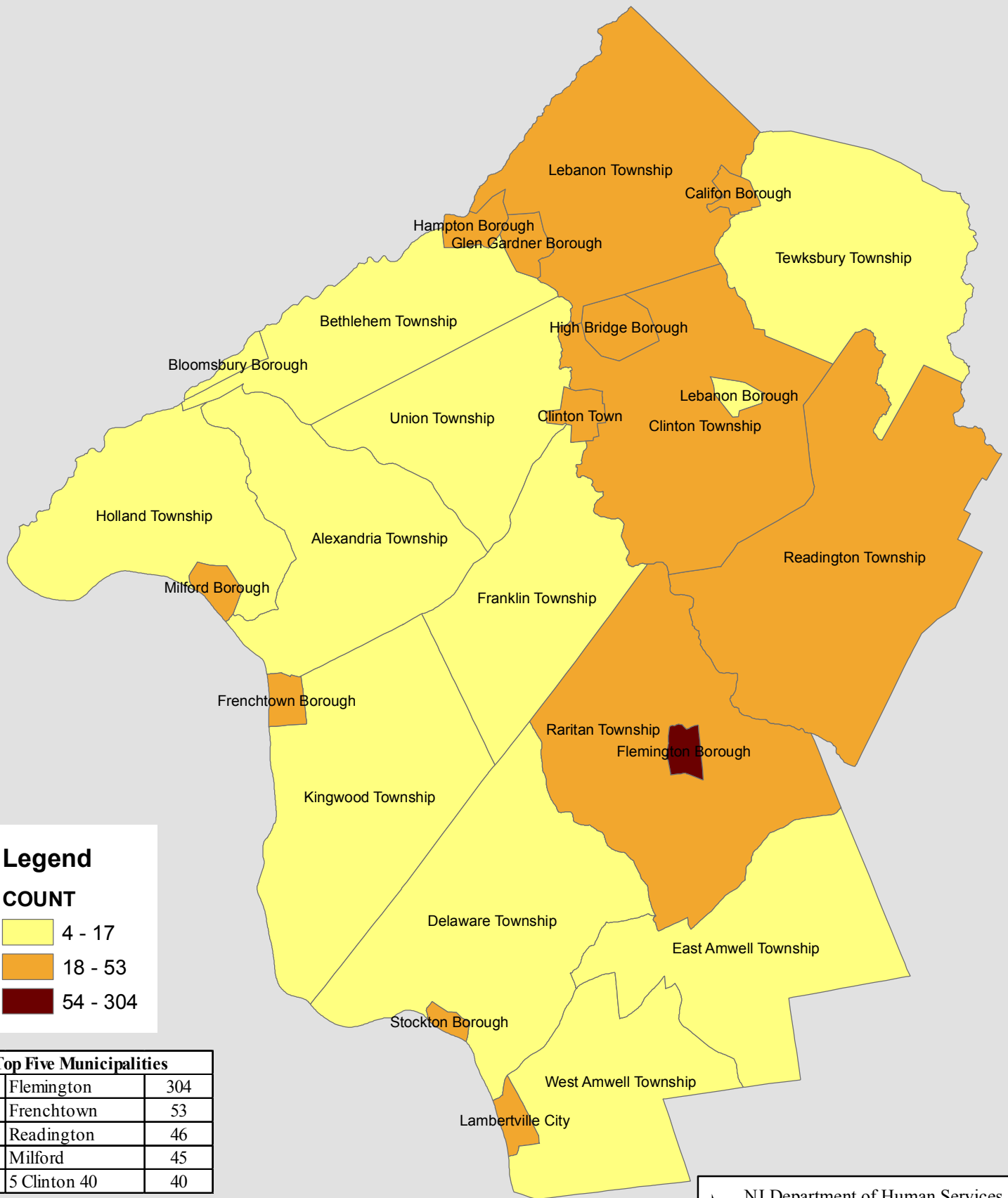

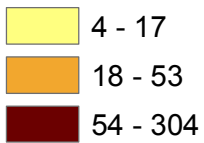
