

This ***Substance Abuse Overview*** provides statistics on substance abuse treatment in each New Jersey county for calendar year 2011. In 2011 there were 74,014 treatment admissions and 72,324 discharges reported to the New Jersey Department of Human Services, Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services by substance abuse treatment providers. 






2011 Warren County Substance Abuse Admissions by Municipality of Residence
