



Comparison Between Cumberland County and New Jersey Adults 2009 NJ Household Survey on Drug Use & Health

The 2009 New Jersey Household Survey on Drug Use and Health was commissioned by the Division of Addiction Services (DAS) with funding from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Center for Substance Abuse Treatment (CSAT), to assess the prevalence of legal and illegal substance use and identify the need and demand for substance abuse treatment. Administration of the survey was carried out by the Bloustein Center for Survey Research (BCSR), Bloustein School of Public Policy at Rutgers, the State University of New Jersey. The survey contained 14,678 respondents, yielding a random sample with a margin of error of +- 0.8%. The Cumberland County portion of the sample had 702 respondents in 2003 and 682 in 2009; therefore county estimates have a margin of error of approximately +- 3.7%. Selected comparisons between Cumberland County and New Jersey as well as Cumberland County in 2003 and 2009 are presented below.
