**Dear Administrator:**

We are writing to notify you of important activities and deadlines for the Fiscal Year 2024 Nursing Facility Quality Incentive Payment Program (QIPP).

Governor Murphy and the Department are committed to continuing and extending the work we began together in Fiscal Year 2020 to link rate enhancements with quality measures. As part of these efforts, the Department will initiate the annual process to collect QIPP data for Fiscal Year 2024 including establishing both QIPP and CoreQ eligibility. As in prior years, CoreQ resident and family minimum sample size for survey and hospital utilization tracking software data is required from your facility through an online survey process.

This year, we are continuing our efforts to streamline the survey process through increased automation. Each Medicaid certified provider (Class I, 11, and III) will be required to data enter the following information directly through the Division of Aging Services online portal:

- Long-Stay Census and Survey Eligibility to establish CoreQ Sample Size
- CoreQ Survey Vendor Intent
- Hospital Utilization Tracking software use


1. **Complete a CoreQ Long-Stay Survey Sample Size Calculation Grid.** This online spreadsheet determines a facility's eligible CoreQ survey size, communicates CoreQ vendor intent, and attests to hospital utilization tracking software use. The last day to complete the online Calculation Grid via <http://njdoas-ua.force.com/NF> is **December 2, 2022 at 5:00pm.**
2. **Submit a CoreQ Long-Stay Demographics for Residents and Families Template.** This template provides a list of survey eligible residents and families along with contact information for survey administration. Facilities that meet the minimum CoreQ sample size and will be utilizing the DHS Core a Vendor, the last day to submit the Template to the DHS CoreQ Vendor is **December 16, 2022 at 5:00pm.** Eligible providers will receive the template from the Division of Aging Services following completion of the calculation grid.
3. **CoreQ Survey vendor data submission.** Facilities that meet the CoreQ requirements and contract directly with a CoreQ vendor, the contracted vendor is responsible for completing the CoreQ survey process and submitting the data to the DHS CoreQ vendor. The due date for submission of vendor collected CoreQ data is **March 10, 2023 at 5:00pm.**
