In a nutshell:

22.7% of NJ's 2018 population was aged 60 or older. 4.2% were aged 80 or older.

37.7% of the falls treated in the ED and released were among those aged 60 or older. 15.8% were among those 80 and older.

82.4% of falls admitted as inpatients were aged 60 or older; 48.5% were aged 80 or older.

43.1% of all falls treated in the ED or admitted were among patients aged 60 or older, and 19.8% were aged 80 or older.

3.1% of NJ residents aged 60 or older were treated and released in the ED for a fall. 7.0% NJ residents aged 80 or older were treated and released in the ED for a fall.

0.9% of NJ residents aged 60 or older were admitted to inpatient care for a fall. That percentage is more than tripled (3.0%) for NJ residents 80 or older.

4.0% of NJ residents aged 60 or older were treated in the ED or as inpatients for a fall, and 9.9% of NJ residents aged 80 or older.
