In a nutshell:

24.5% of NJ's 2024 population was aged 60 or older. 4.2% were aged 80 or older.

46.0% of the falls treated in the ED and released were among those aged 60 or older. 18.2% were among those 80 and older.  
85.0% of falls admitted as inpatients were aged 60 or older; 47.5% were aged 80 or older.  
50.4% of all falls treated in the ED or admitted were among patients aged 60 or older, and 21.5% were aged 80 or older.

4.0% of NJ residents aged 60 or older were treated and released in the ED for a fall. 9.2% NJ residents aged 80 or older were treated and released in the ED for a fall.  
0.9% of NJ residents aged 60 or older were admitted to inpatient care for a fall. That percentage is more than tripled (3.1%) for NJ residents 80 or older.  
4.9% of NJ residents aged 60 or older were treated in the ED or as inpatients for a fall, and 12.3% of NJ residents aged 80 or older.

The county with the highest population percentage of residents 60 and older is Cape May, with 40.4% of residents aged 60+. CMC also has the highest percentage of over 80 years of age at 6.7% of residents.  
The county with the lowest population percentage of residents 60 and older is Hudson, with 18.0% of residents aged 60+. Hudson also has the lowest percentage of over 80 years of age at 3.1% of residents
