EDUCATION	Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree in Social Work, Social Case Work, Vocational Rehabilitation, Guidance and Counseling, Psychology, Nursing, Pastoral Counseling, Special Education, Art, Music, Art Therapy, Music Therapy, Social Science, Education, Sociology, Occupational Therapy or Recreation.				
EXPERIENCE	Three (3) years of experience in mental health in the field of social case work, vocational rehabilitation, guidance and counseling, psychology, nursing, pastoral counseling, education or other related allied fields.				
NOTE	A Master's degree in any educational area specified above may be substituted for one (1) year of experience.				
NOTE FOR FOREIGN DEGREES	Degrees and/or transcripts issued by a college or university outside of the United States must be evaluated by a reputable evaluation service at your expense. The evaluation must be included with your submission. Failure to submit the required evaluation may result in an ineligibility determination.				
LICENSE	Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.				
IMPORTANT NOTICE					
RESIDENCY	Effective 9/1/11, NJ PL 70 (NJ First Act), requires all State employees to reside in New Jersey, unless exempted under the law, or current employees who live out-of-state and do not have a break-in service of more than 7 calendar days, as they are "grandfathered." New employees or current employees who were not grandfathered and who live out-of-state have one year after the date of employment to relocate their residence to New Jersey or request an exemption. Current employees who reside in NJ must retain NJ residency, unless he/she obtains an exemption. Employees who fail to meet the residency requirements or obtain an exemption will be removed from employment.
