OPEN TO:	Current State Employees			
DEFINITION:	Under supervision of a supervisory official in a state department, institution, or agency, performs moderately difficult personnel work pertinent to one or more major personnel program areas such as classification, recruitment, personnel orientation and training, personnel research, administrative services, employee counseling and personnel services, and management assistance; does other related work.			
NOTE:	Knowledge of leave of absences, Family Medical Leave Act and NJ State Family Leave Act is preferred, but not necessary.			
	RE	QUIREMENTS		
EDUCATION:	Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree.			
EXPERIENCE:	Two (2) years of technical experience in a personnel program of a public or private organization.			
	Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute experience as indicated on a year for year basis, with thirt (30) semester credit hours being equal to one (1) year of experience.			
NOTE:	A Master's degree in business administration, personnel administration, public administration, management, or other may be substituted for one (1) year of the indicated experience.			
LICENSE:	Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position. IMPORTANT NOTICES			
NOTE FOR FOREIGN DEGREES:	Degrees and/or transcripts issued by a college or university outside of the United States must be evaluated by a reputable evaluation service at your expense. The evaluation must be included with your submission. Failure to submit the required evaluation may result in an ineligibility determination.			
RESIDENCY:	Effective 9/1/11, NJ PL 70 (NJ First Act), requires all State employees to reside in New Jersey, unless exempted under the law, or current employees who live out-of-state and do not have a break-in service of more than 7 calendar days, as they are "grandfathered." New employees or current employees who were not grandfathered and who live out-of-state have one year after the date of employment to relocate their residence to New Jersey or request an exemption. Current employees who reside in NJ must retain NJ residency, unless he/she obtains an exemption. Employees who fail to meet the residency requirements or obtain an exemption will be removed from employment.			
DRUG SCREENING:	If you are a candidate for a position that involves direct client care with the Department of Human Services, you may be subject to pre and/or post-employment drug testing/ screening. The cost of any pre-employment testing will be at your expense. Candidates with a positive drug test result or those who refuse to be tested and/or cooperate with the testing requirement will not be hired. You will be advised if the position for which you're being considered requires drug testing and how to proceed with the testing.			
NOTE:	* Applicable regular or special re-employment list(s) established as a result of a layoff will be used before promotions are made. * Telework: This position may be eligible to participate in the Department's pilot "Telework Program", which offers eligible employees the opportunity to work remotely for up to two (2) days per week, as approved by management.
