DEFINITION	Under supervision of a supervisory official, in a state department, institution, or agency, operates, services, makes minor repairs to, loads, and unloads trucks with single rear axles; does related work as required.

EDUCATION							
Experience	One (1) year of experience in work involving the operation and routine maintenance of trucks with single rear axles, (i.e., flatbed - 12 foot, 6-8 yard dump truck, tow truck, armored truck, 2 yard dump truck and van - 18-22 foot bed) and other motorized equipment (i.e., snow blowers, salt spreaders, and lift tail gate).						
Νοτε	Appointees must possess a valid Commercial Driver's License (CDL) and applicable endorsements for the class and type of vehicle being operated. The responsibility for ensuring that employees possess the required motor vehicle license, commensurate with the class and type of vehicles they operate, rests with the Appointing Authority. In Department of Human Services, may be required to undergo fire training classes.						
NOTE FOR FOREIGN DEGREES	Degrees and/or transcripts issued by a college or university outside of the United States must be evaluated by a reputable evaluation service at your expense. The evaluation must be included with your submission. Failure to submit the required evaluation may result in an ineligibility determination.						
LICENSE	Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey only if the operation of a vehicle, rather than employee mobility, is necessary to perform the essential duties of the position.						
IMPORTANT NOTICE							
RESIDENCY	Effective 9/1/11, NJ PL 70 (NJ First Act), requires all State employees to reside in New Jersey, unless exempted under the law, or current employees who live out-of-state and do not have a break-in service of more than 7 calendar days, as they are "grandfathered." New employees or current employees who were not grandfathered and who live out-of-state have one year after the date of employment to relocate their residence to New Jersey or request an exemption. Current employees who reside in NJ must retain NJ residency, unless he/she obtains an exemption. Employees who fail to meet the residency requirements or obtain an exemption will be removed from employment.						
Νοτε		Applicable special re-employment list established as a result of a layoff will be used before any promotions are made.					
Drug Screening	If you are a candidate for a position that involves direct client care in one of the Department of Human Services' hospitals or developmental centers, you may be subject to pre and/or post-employment drug testing/ screening.
