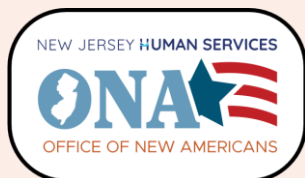

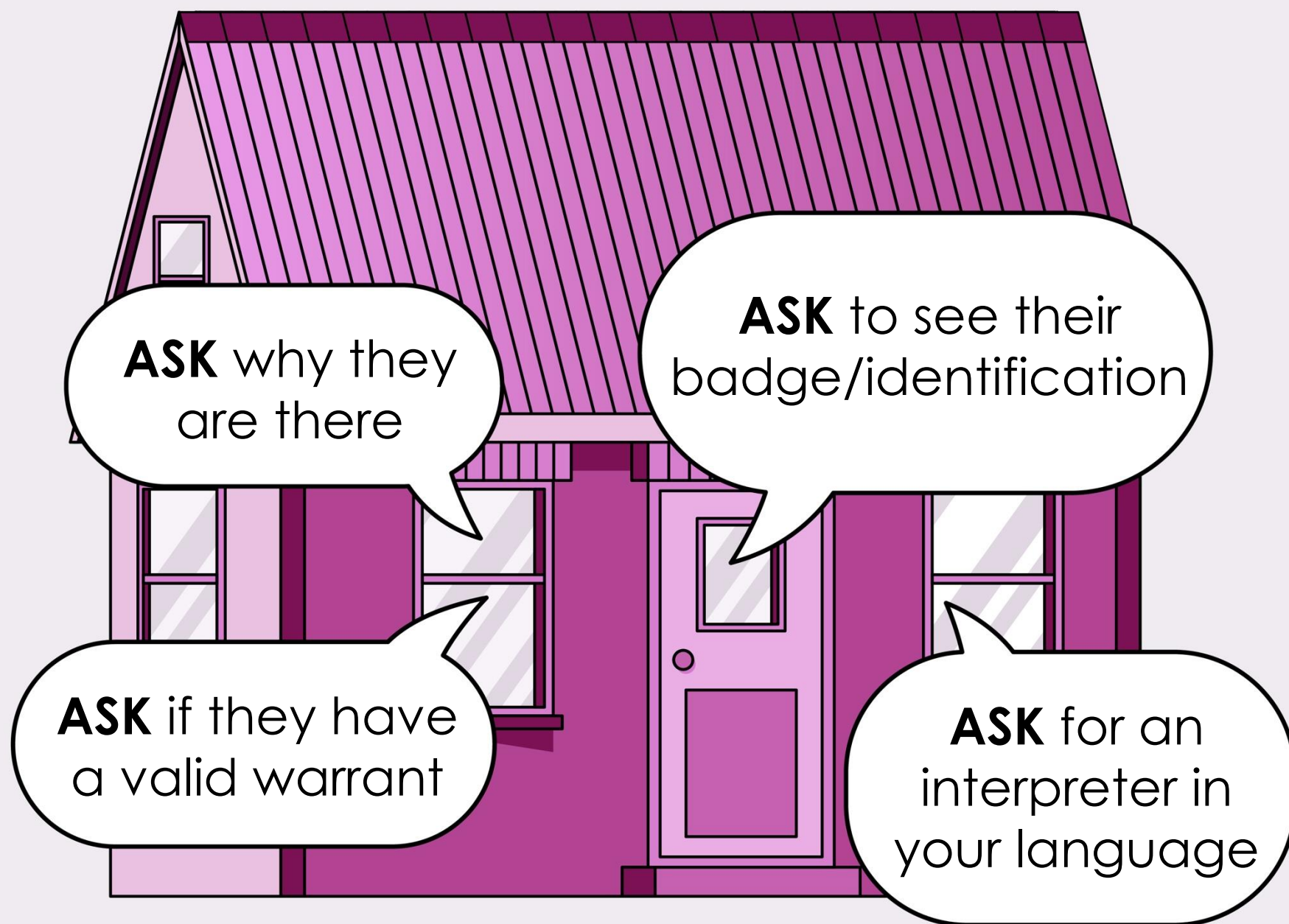

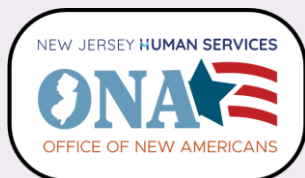


If an immigration agent comes to your home, DO NOT open the door.

Through a window or under the door...



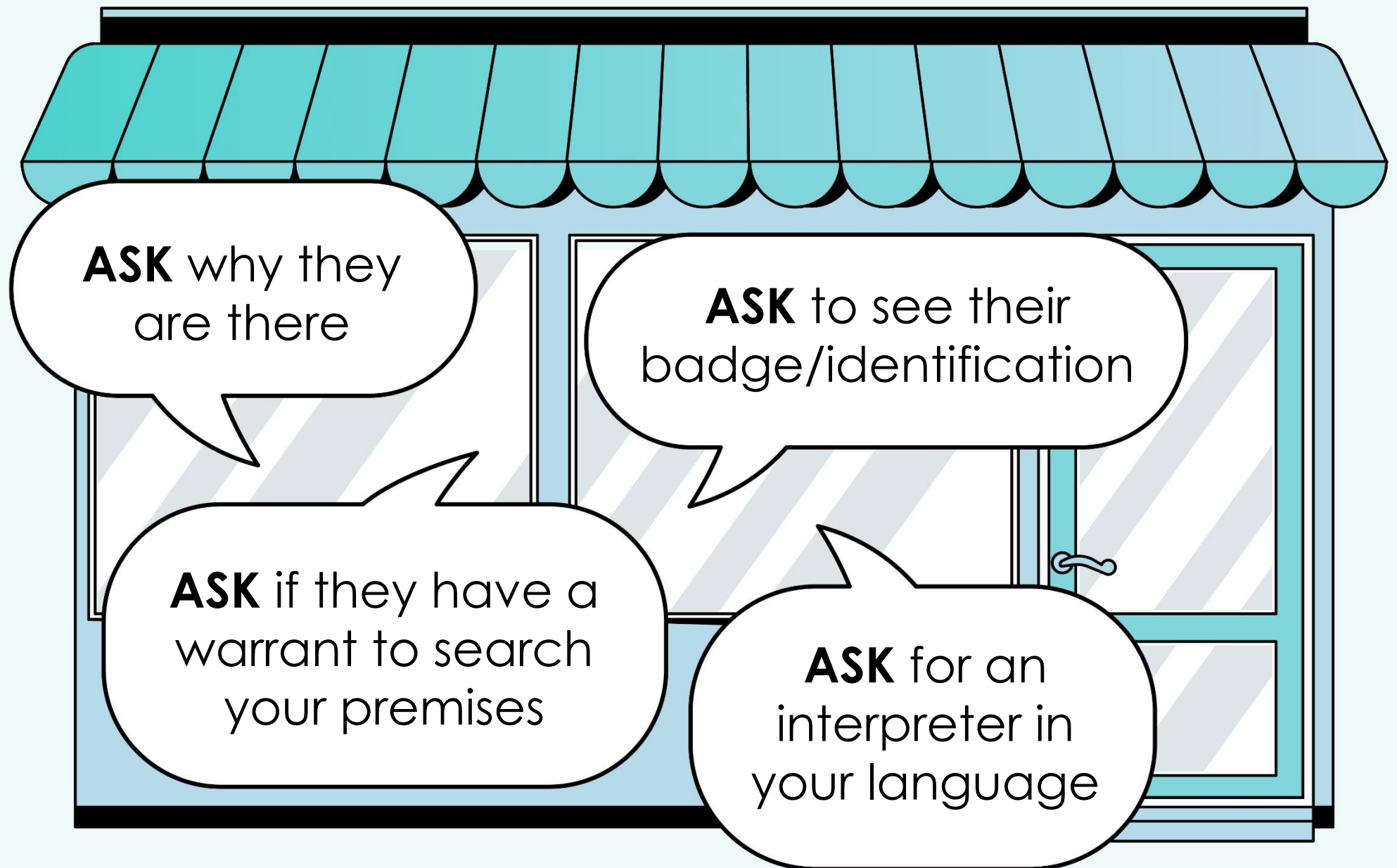
Remember: You have the right to remain silent.



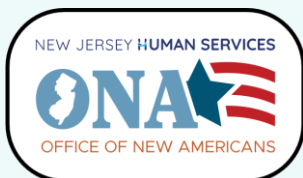

Remember: Agents can enter a private area **ONLY** if they have a judicial warrant.

If you encounter an immigration agent in a public space

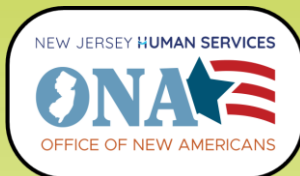
ASK to see their badge/identification

ASK for an interpreter in your language

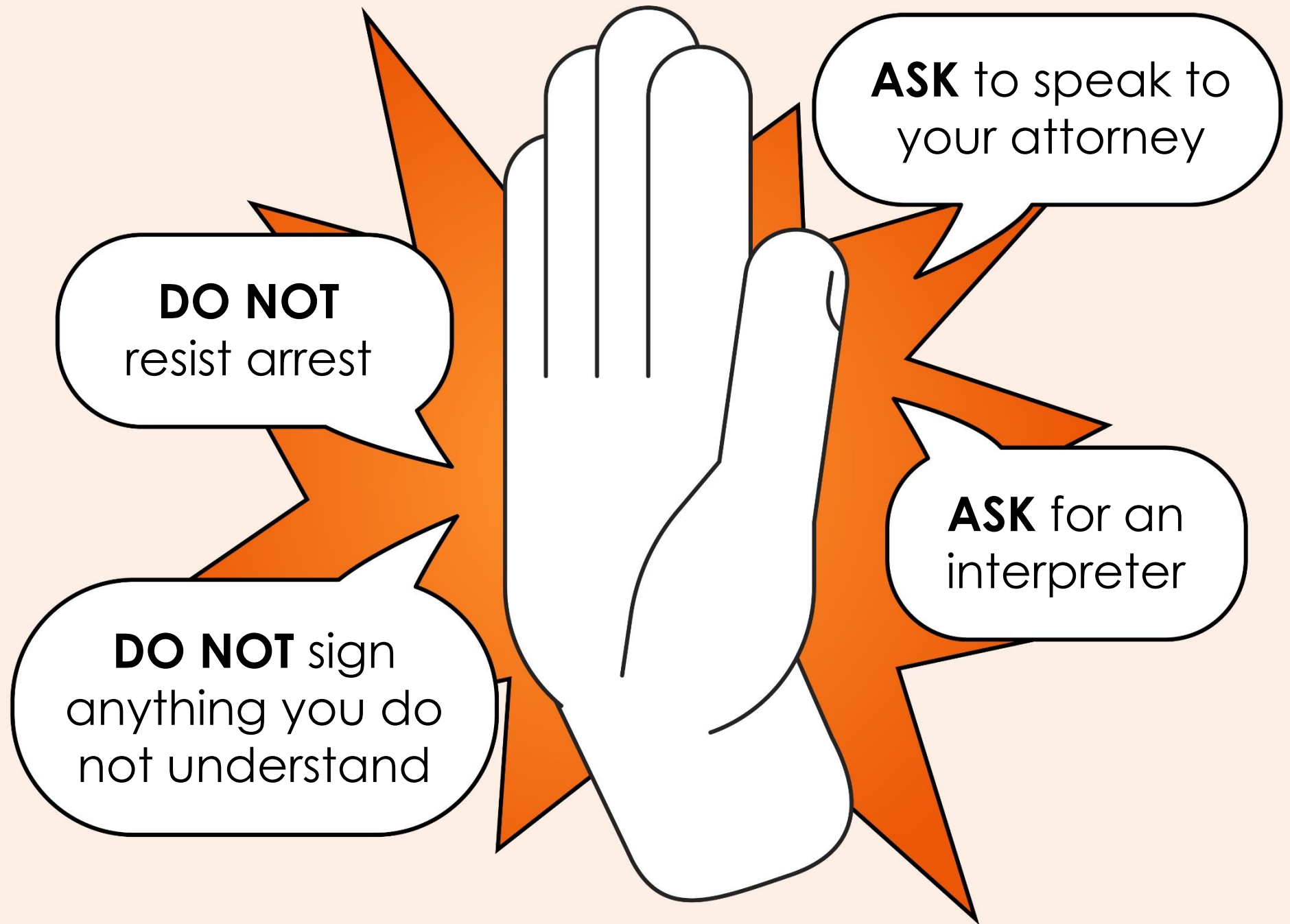

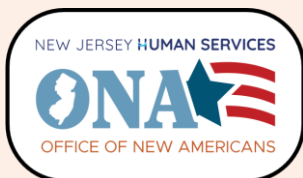
