Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE)

TAKE NOTICE that the New Jersey Division of Aging Services (DOAS), in coordination with the New Jersey Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services (DMAHS) intend to seek approval from the United States Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), for an amendment to the New Jersey Medicaid (Title XIX) State Plan to update the PACE rate setting methodology. The update will include an updated description of the Amount Would Otherwise Have Paid (AWOP) and Capitated Rate Setting methodology.

The PACE State Plan Amendment affects the AWOPs and Capitated Rates for all PACE organizations operating throughout New Jersey. There is no anticipated additional cost associated with the subsequent State Plan Amendment.
