\$350 PER DAY

Assessed until reported or DHS becomes aware.

FAILURE TO REPORT

Suspected Abuse, Neglect or Exploitation



REPORT IMMEDIATELY

Suspected abuse, neglect, or exploitation must be reported **immediately** per your **Agency Policy**.

anonymously to:

WHO MUST REPORT

- Provider staff and contracted personnel
- Employees and volunteers in DHS-funded or licensed programs
- Support Coordinators and Supervisors (case managers under law)



WHAT TO REPORT

- Any reasonable suspicion of abuse, neglect, or exploitation
- Proof is not required



HOW TO REPORT

- Follow your agency policies and protocols
- To report anonymously, call 1-800-832-9173



WHAT "IMMEDIATELY" MEANS

- Do not wait to investigate or confirm facts
- Do not delay to consult internally
- Report as soon as you suspect



WHAT IS FAILURE TO REPORT

- No report made
- Delayed report
- Waiting for internal verification



WHY THIS MATTERS

- Delays increase risk of harm
- Immediate reporting enables intervention
- Required to protect individuals
