\$350 PER DAY

Assessed until reported or DHS becomes aware.

FAILURE TO REPORT

Suspected Abuse, Neglect or Exploitation



REPORT IMMEDIATELY

If you suspect abuse, neglect, or exploitation, report right away.



REPORT ABUSE

Call **1-800-832-9173**



WHO MUST REPORT

- Provider staff and contracted personnel
- Employees and volunteers in DHS-funded or licensed programs
- Support Coordinators and Supervisors (case managers under law)



WHAT TO REPORT

- Any reasonable suspicion of abuse, neglect, or exploitation
- Proof is not required



WHAT "IMMEDIATELY" MEANS

- Do not wait to investigate or confirm facts
- Do not delay to consult internally
- Report as soon as you suspect



WHAT IS FAILURE TO REPORT

- No report made
- Delayed report
- Waiting for internal verification



HOW VIOLATIONS ARE IDENTIFIED

- Incident reviews and investigations
- Monitoring and documentation
- Timeline of awareness vs reporting



WHY THIS MATTERS

- Delays increase risk of harm
- Immediate reporting enables intervention
- Required to protect individuals
