

reject, or modify the Initial Decision within 45 days of the agency's receipt. The Initial Decision in this case was received on November 18, 2014.

At issue is the effective date of Petitioner's eligibility for the Global Options Program. The evidence in the record shows that Petitioner was determined clinically eligible in July 2013 and financially eligible in September 2013. Accordingly, the ALJ found that the Petitioner was eligible for the Global Options Program effective September 1, 2013. After reviewing the record, I concur with the ALJ's finding and ADOPT the Initial Decision in its entirety.

THEREFORE, it is on this 12th day of DECEMBER, 2014,

ORDERED:

That the Initial Decision is hereby ADOPTED.
