

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 9

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 8, declaring a State of Emergency across all 21 counties in New Jersey, was issued on Friday, January 23, 2026, due to the anticipated statewide impact of a severe winter storm, including significant snowfall, extreme cold temperatures, wind gusts, and icy conditions; and

WHEREAS, the severity of the conditions necessitating the State of Emergency declaration has eased;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MIKIE SHERRILL, Governor of the State of New Jersey, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and by the Statutes of this State, do hereby ORDER and DIRECT:

1. The State of Emergency declared pursuant to Executive Order No. 8 (2026) is terminated effective 12:00 p.m., Eastern Standard Time, on Monday, January 26, 2026.
