

# Paid leave when you need it most

Receive up to **85% of your average weekly wages** to cope with domestic/sexual violence, up to a maximum amount.

Most NJ workers are covered and your job may be protected under state and/or federal law.

## Survivors can receive benefits to

- Seek medical attention and recover
- Get therapy, victim advocacy, or legal services
- Safety plan or escape abuse
- Attend or prepare for court
- Care for a loved one who is a survivor

## You may qualify if you...

- Recently worked in NJ
- Meet earnings requirements
- Have a valid Social Security Number
