Personal attention

■ We offer many programs and services, especially for people who need extra help finding work. Be sure to tell your counselor if you fit into one of these groups: laid-off workers, youth, ex-offenders, people with limited English skills, and people without a high school diploma. Many offices also have vocational counselors for people with disabilities, and veterans representatives for former military personnel who are making the switch to civilian careers.

NEED NEW SKILLS?

Skills assessment

 Ask your counselor for a skills assessment to determine your strengths.

No-cost computer tutorials

 Refresh your math, English or basic computer skills with free computer tutorials.

Financial assistance

 You may be able to get help, tuition waivers, or training grants to learn skills that can help you qualify for a good job.

Training

 Apprenticeships and on-the-job training build skills while providing a paycheck. Talk with your counselor about requirements for these opportunities.
