Summary of Public Comment and Agency Response:

No comments were received.

Federal Standards Statement

The adopted amendments do not include any standards or requirements that exceed standards or requirements imposed by Federal law. The amendments adjust the maximum weekly workers' compensation benefit rate and is governed entirely by State law; specifically, the New Jersey Workers' Compensation Act, N.J.S.A. 34:15-1 et seq. As a result, an explanation or analysis of the adopted amendments pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-23 or N.J.A.C. 1:30-5.1 is not required.

Full text of the adoption follows:

SUBCHAPTER 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

12:235-1.6 Maximum workers' compensation benefit rates

(a) In accordance with the provisions at N.J.S.A. 34:15-12(a), the maximum workers' compensation benefit rate for temporary disability, permanent total disability, permanent partial disability, and dependency is hereby promulgated as being \$ 1,099 per week.

(b) The maximum compensation shall be effective as to injuries occurring in the calendar year 2023.
