Subject: Workers' Compensation Discovery Issues Committee

Both petitioner and respondent attorneys have raised concerns with our workers' compensation discovery process. Some present that there are abuses as to motions, subpoenas and contacts with petitioner personal physicians. Others claim that there is a need for greater information on pre-existing conditions and a mechanism to ensure against fraudulent or misleading statements or claims.

In consultation with the Workers' Compensation Section of the State Bar Association, we have formed a Committee to review discovery issues and to make recommendations as to any useful changes, deletions or modifications to current discovery court rules or policies.
