




#### **Monthly Total Nonfarm Employment**




#### **Monthly Private Sector Employment Change**

Average monthly change of +2,300 jobs over the past 12 months.




#### Month-Over-Month Employment Change: April 2025



#### Year-Over-Year Employment Change: Apr 2024 – Apr 2025








## New Jersey Labor Force Participation Rate and Employment to Population Ratio






#### **New Jersey Employed Residents**



(Preliminary, Not Seasonally Adjusted)





(Preliminary, Not Seasonally Adjusted)




