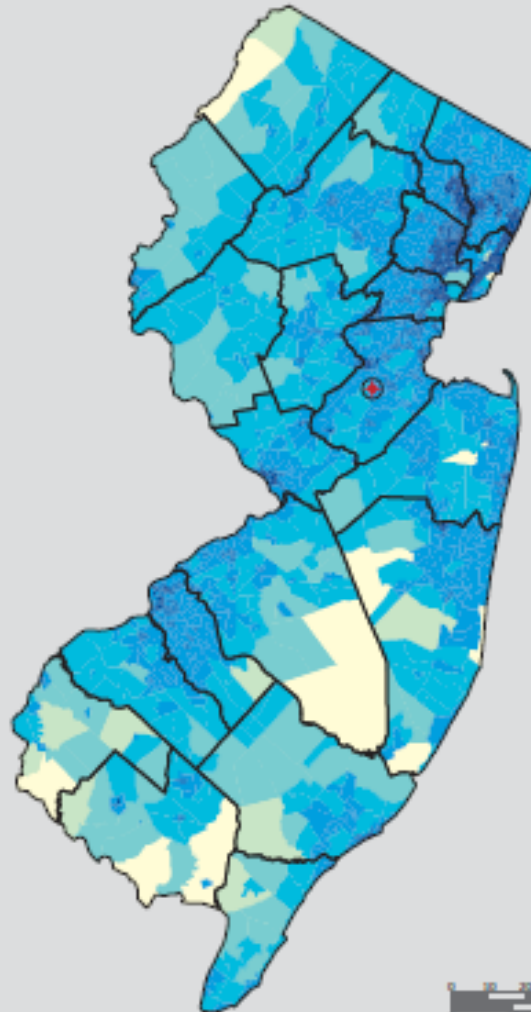
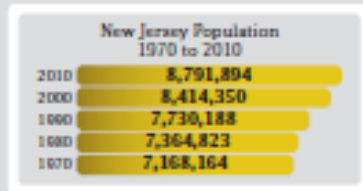

Population Density by Census Tract

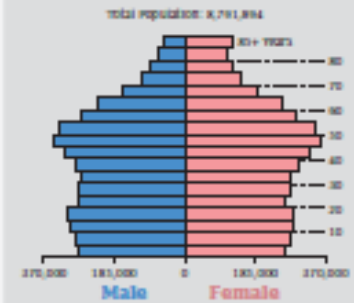

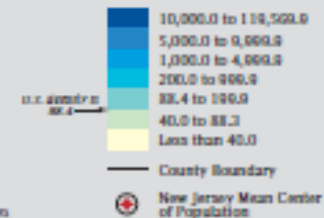
Population by Sex and Age

Sample Data !

The Census Bureau recommends that you:

- ✓ DO compare similar period lengths, for example, 3-year to 3-year.
- ⚠ DON'T compare estimates from different period lengths, for example, 1-year to 3-year.
- ✓ DO compare estimates from non-overlapping periods, for example, compare a 2005-2007 ACS 3-year estimate to a 2008-2010 ACS 3-year estimate.
- ⚠ DON'T compare overlapping periods, for example, the 2005-2007 ACS 3-year estimates to the 2006-2008 ACS 3-year estimates.

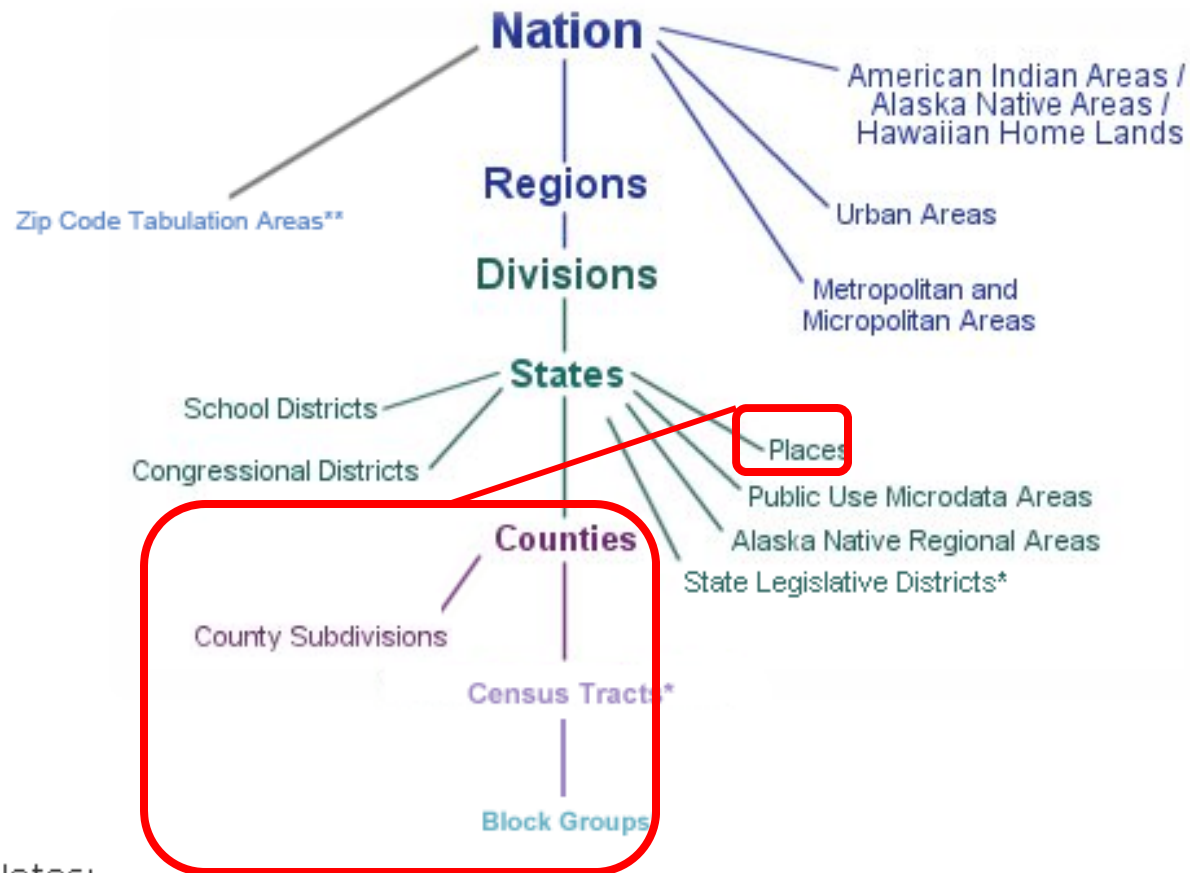

Hierarchy of Select Geographic Entities in the American Community Survey



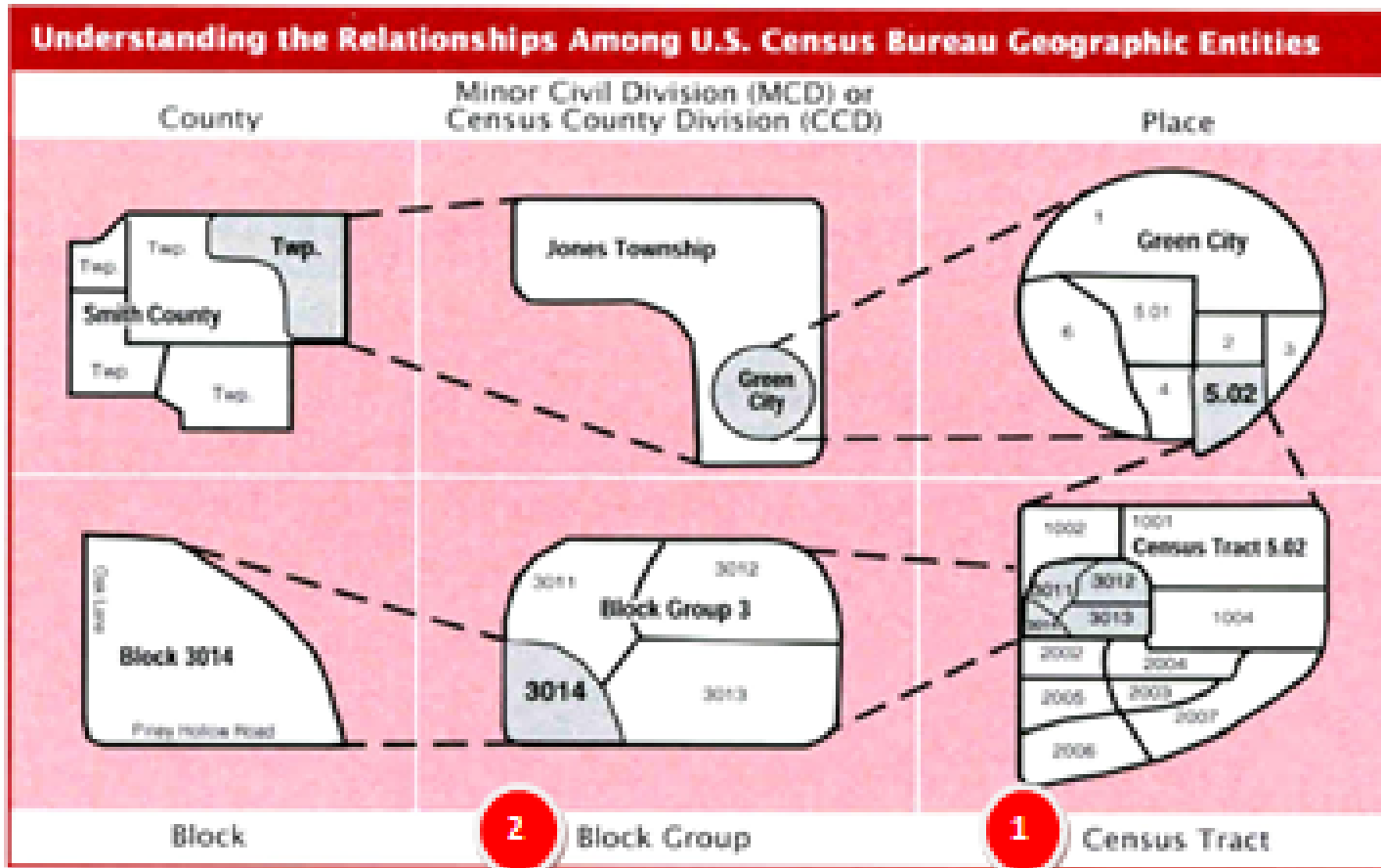

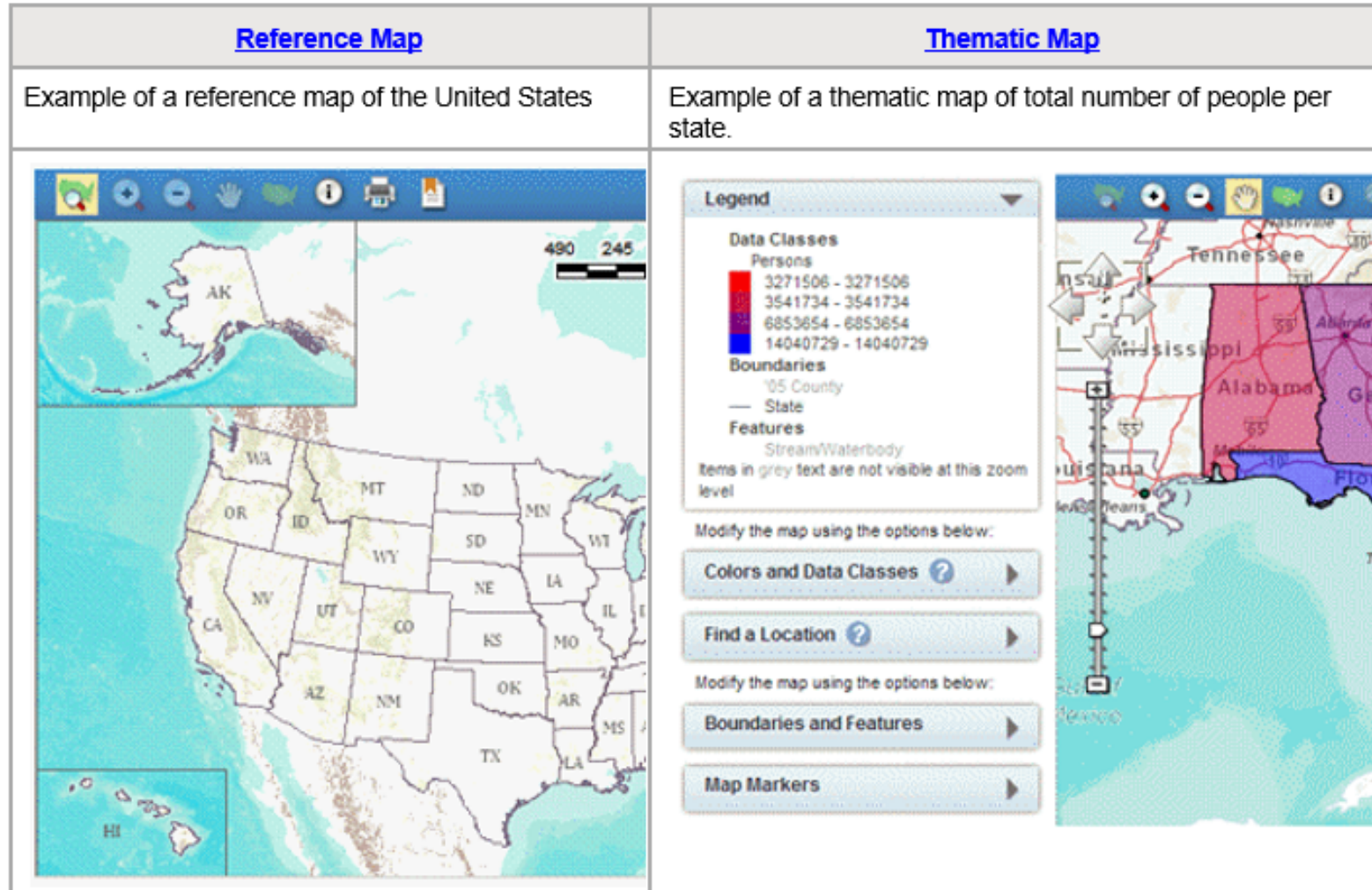

Census Small-Area Geography



1. **Census Tracts** are small, relatively permanent statistical subdivisions and generally have a population of 1,500 to 8,000 (optimum 4,000).
2. **Block Groups** are subdivisions of a census tract and generally have a population of 300 to 4,000 (optimum 1,500).



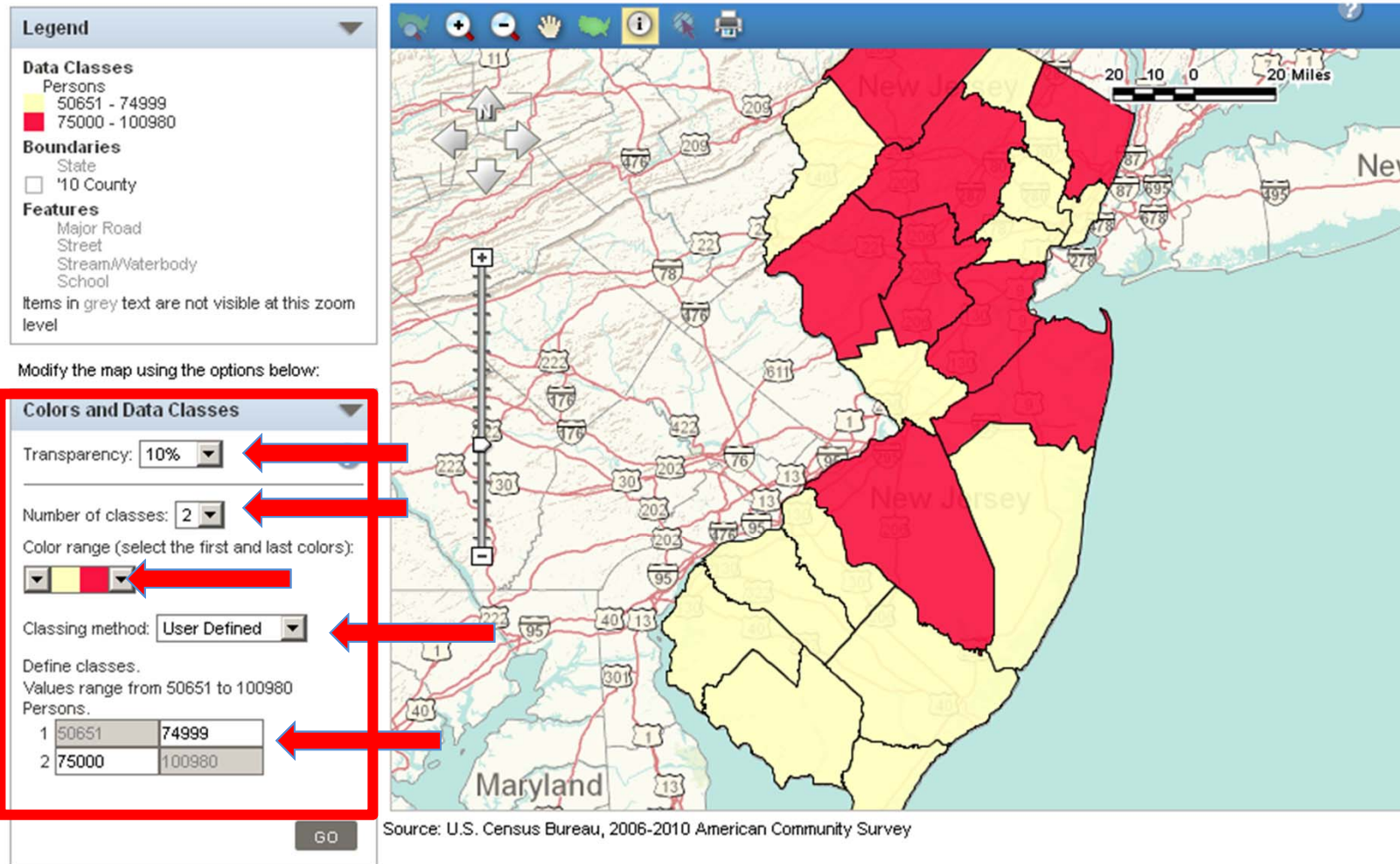

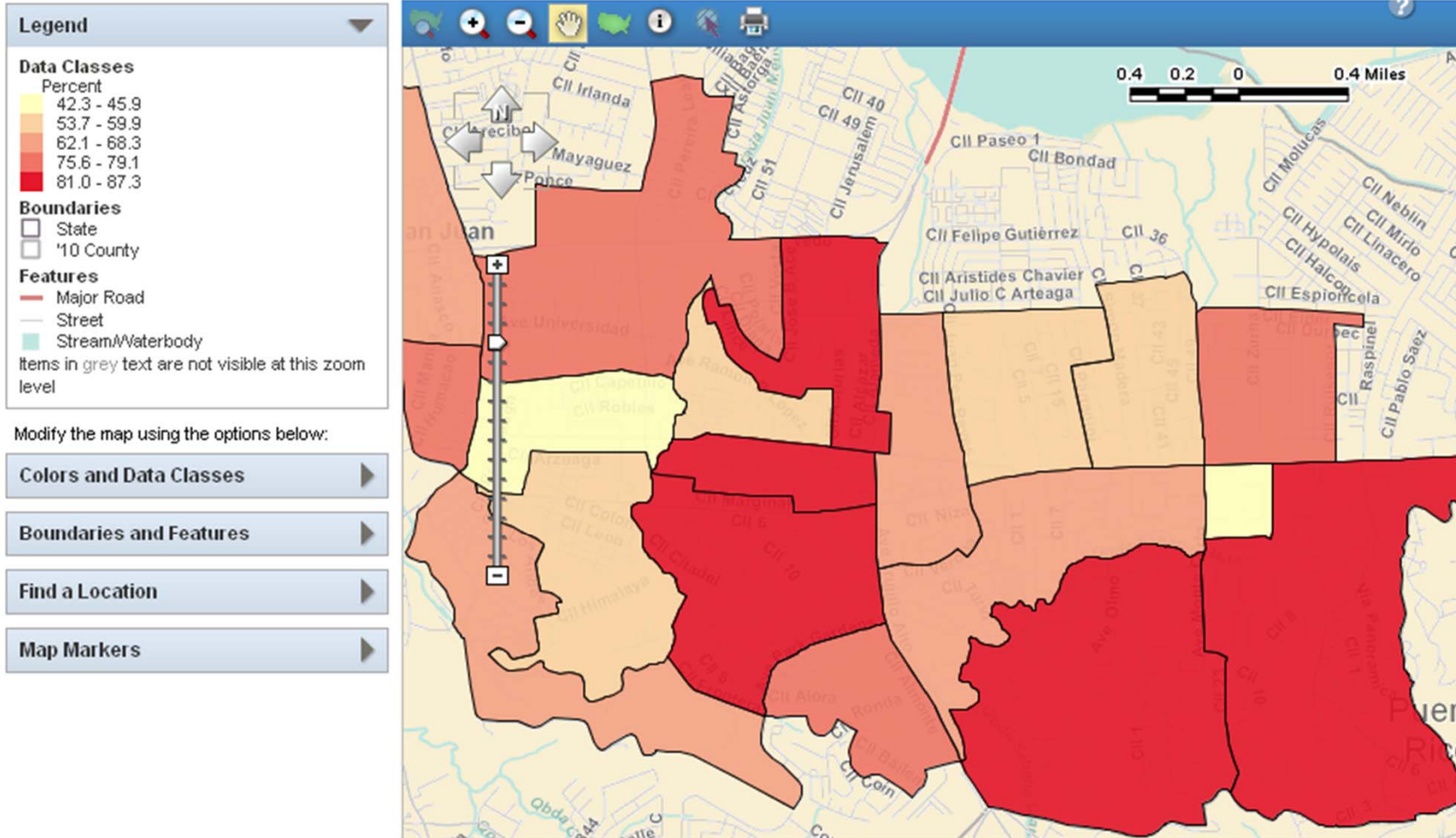

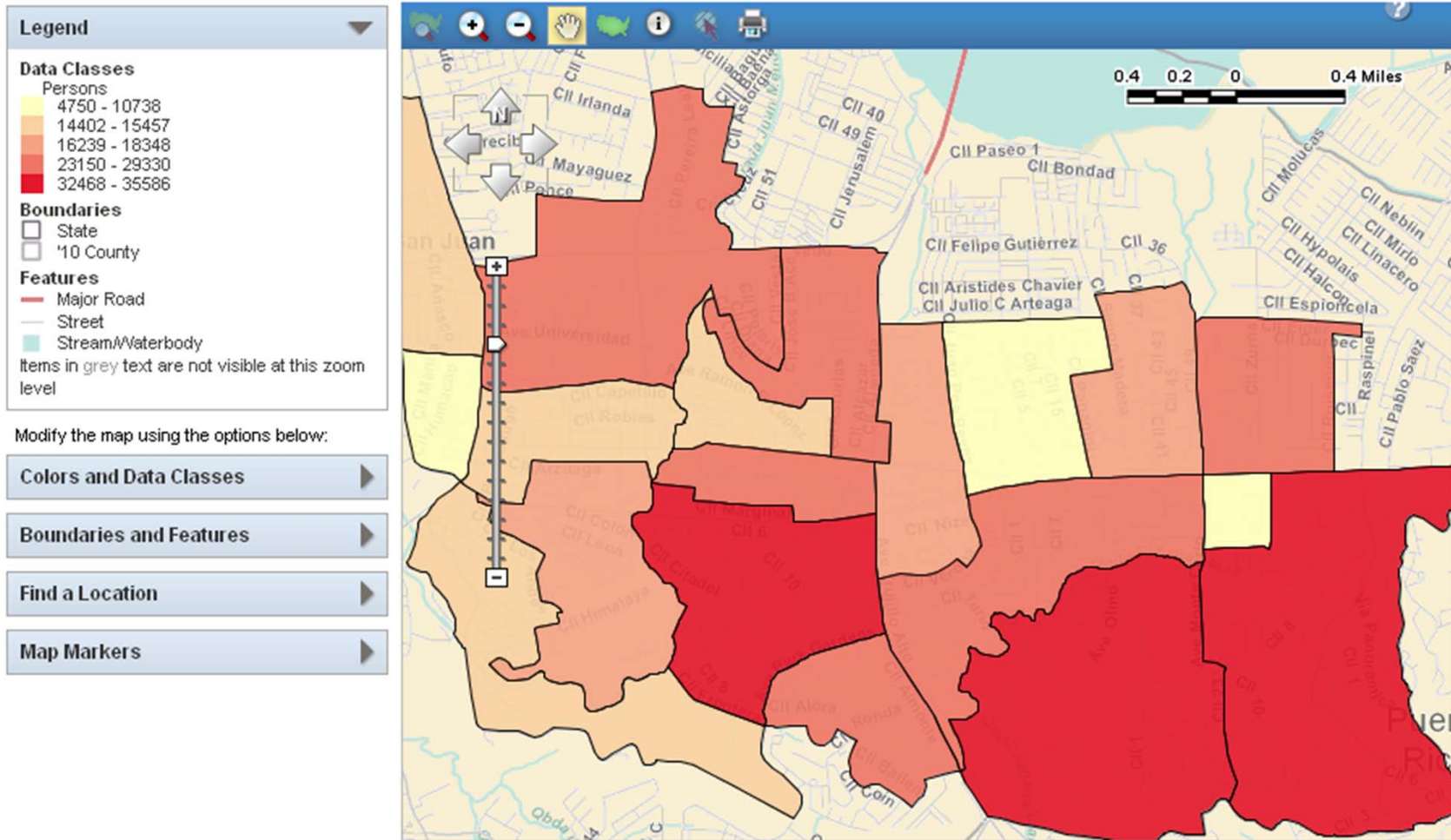

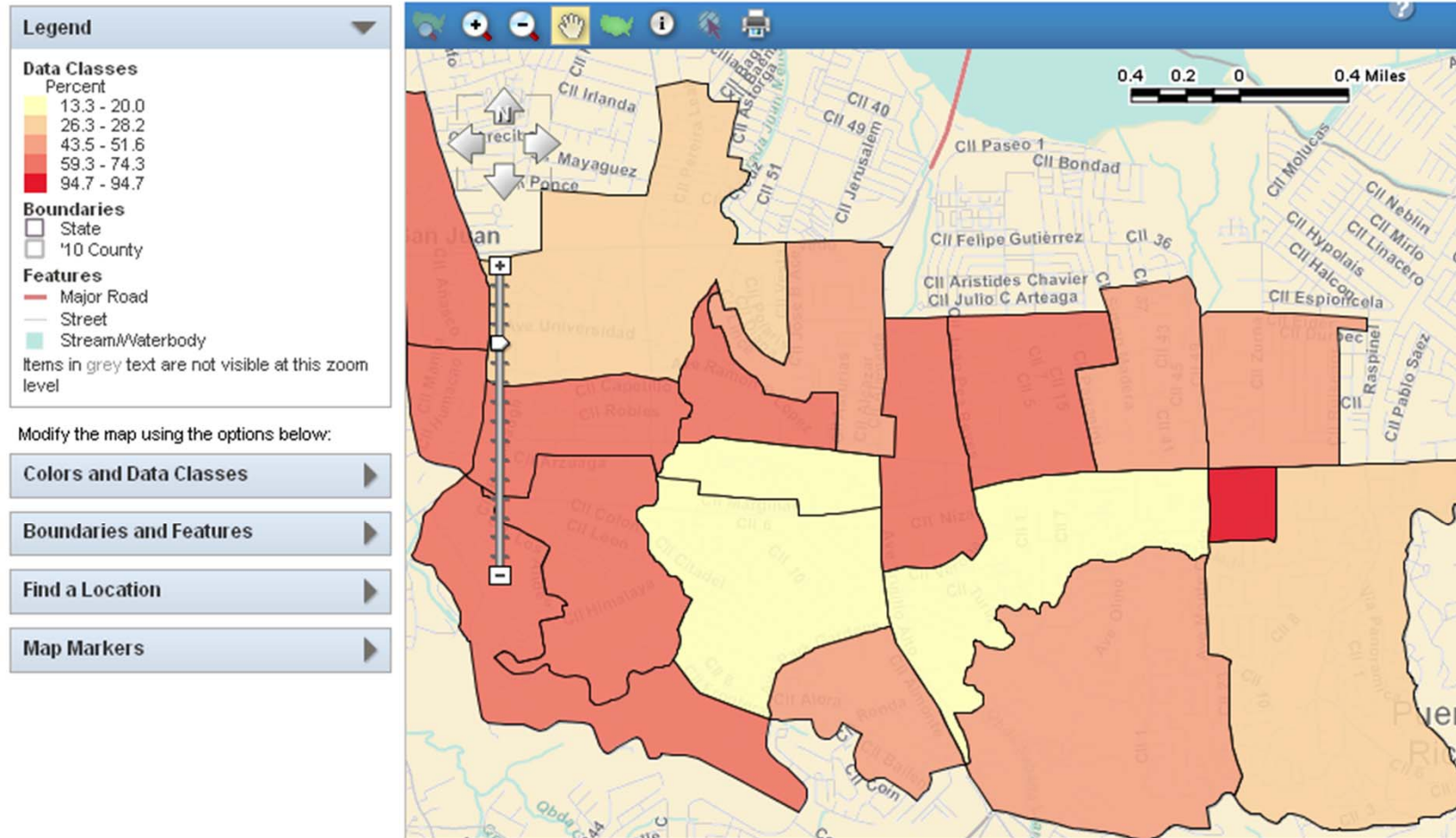
