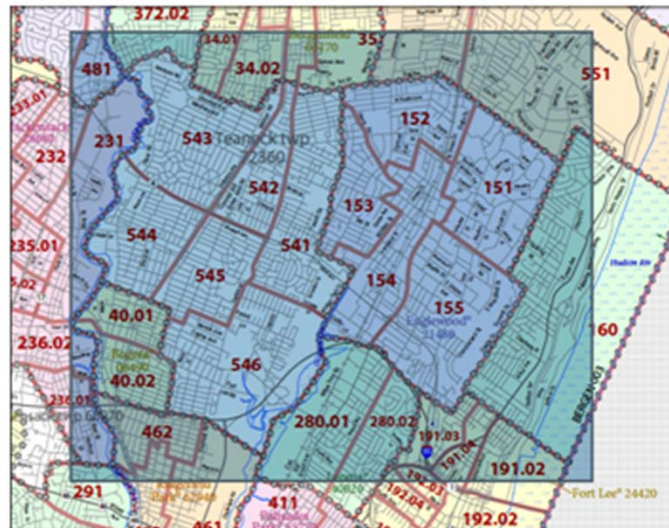

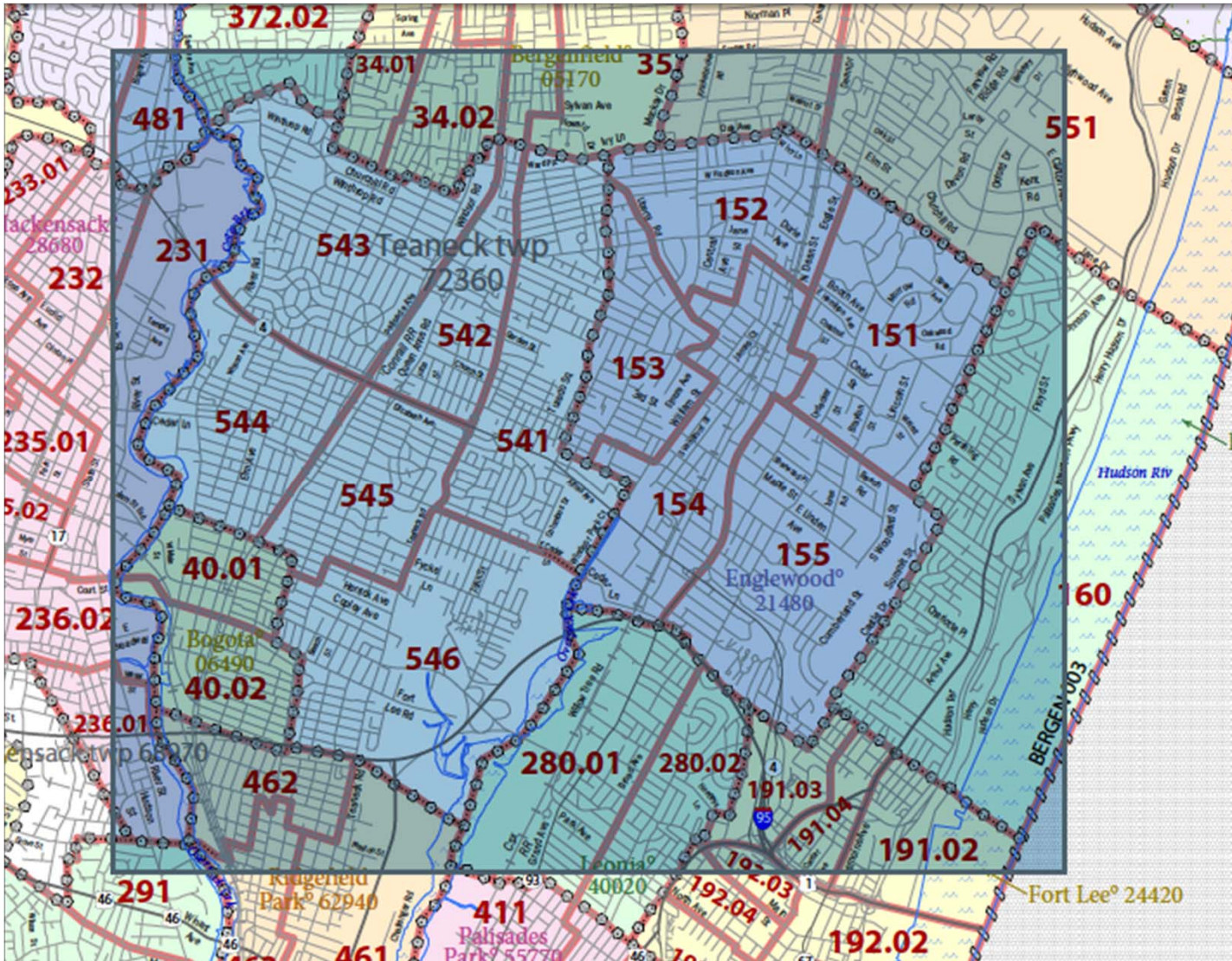

Mapping

Census.gov>Geography tab>Maps and Mapping Resources> Map Products> Reference Maps>2010 Census Reference>Census tract Reference Maps>New Jersey>Bergen County (3 map sheets)>Use map ending with 000.pdf>Use binoculars (Find) to locate Teaneck and Englewood (map sheet 2).

TOPICS

Census.gov>DATA tab>American FactFinder>Left side –TOPICS>open HOUSING> open FINANCIAL characteristics>select REAL ESTATE TAXES >Close overlay (50 tables)

GEOGRAPHY – LIST METHOD

GEOGRAPHY>LIST tab>County Subdivision>State-New Jersey>County-BERGEN>select Englewood City & Teaneck Twp> ADD to your Selections>Close geography overlay (22 tables)

TOPICS – DATA SET

Click on TOPICS> Select DATA SET>Restrict to American Community Survey (ACS 5- year estimate)>Close overlay (3 tables)

Select Table B25102>check off box or click on hyperlink>table results appear

Geography – Census Tracts- Actions

GEOGRAPHY – NAME METHOD

GEOGRAPHY>NAME tab>enter a Geography name (Teaneck) in text box>GO >Select from Geography Results> All Census tracts within Teaneck Township, Bergen County> use Check off box or click on hyperlink>close overlay> reselect the B25102

Actions: Modify-Bookmark-Print-Download- Create a Map

Modify - Transpose rows and columns

- Show-hide

- Collapse/expand

- Rearrange columns/rows

- Sort ascending/descending/Filter Rows

Bookmark – Create a bookmark

- Save a query

Print – Print a PDF version

Download – Comma delimited or presentation ready formats

Create A Map – Appears in Blue – Click on hyperlink to create a map

American Community Survey – Insurance Coverage: Health Insurance

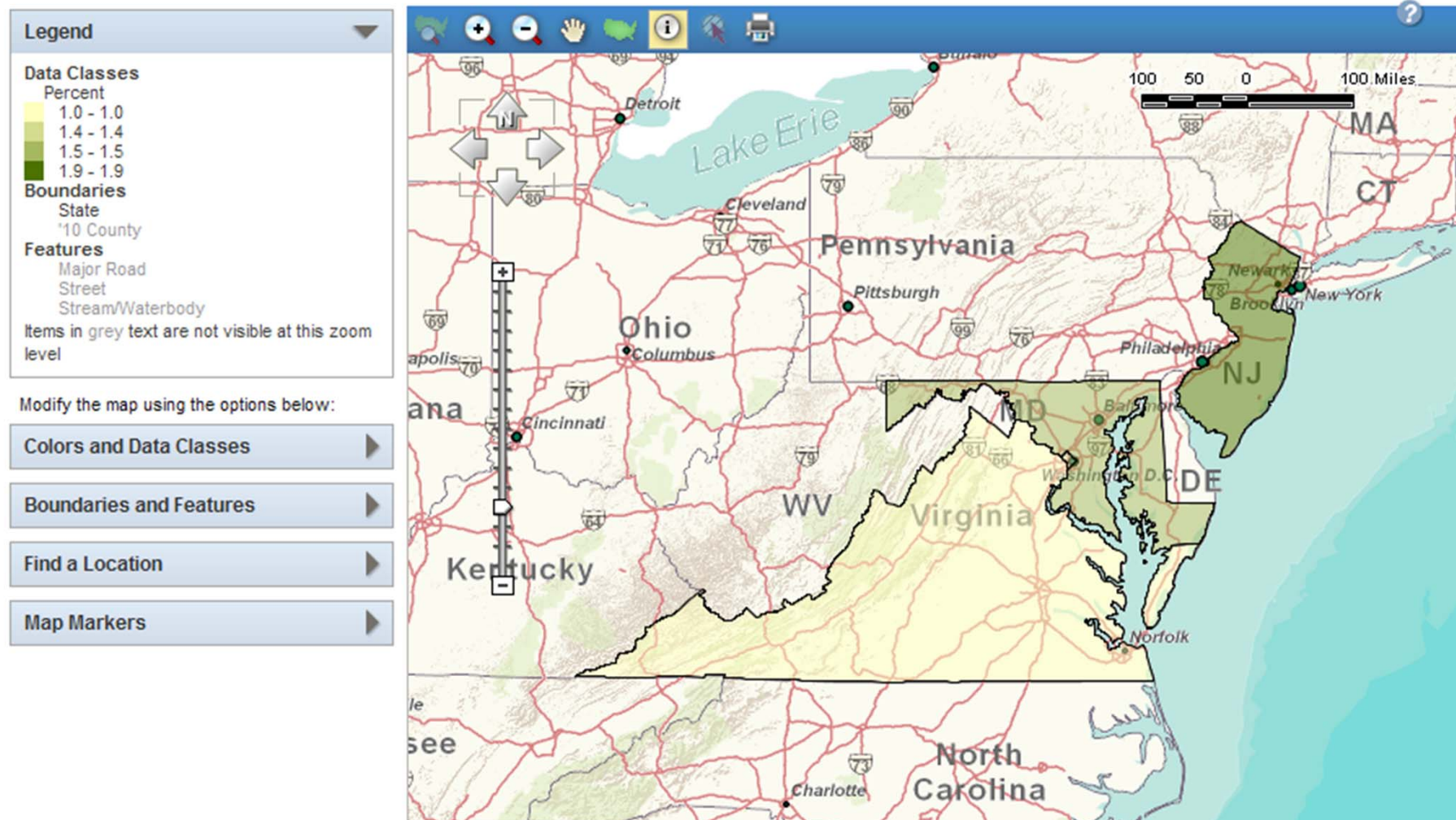
Using the American Community Survey 2010 one year estimate data, which state, District of Columbia, Maryland, New Jersey or Virginia has the highest percentage of uninsured population ages 65 years and older? What is that percentage? Create a map.

HINTS: AFF > Topics tab > Topics = People > People = Insurance Coverage > Close Select Topics window > Geographies tab > Geography Results = Expand per page to 50 > Geography Results = District of Columbia, Maryland, New Jersey and Virginia > Add > Close Select Geographies window > Table S2701 > View > Create a Map > Click 65 years and older row & percent uninsured column on any state > Select a Data Value to Map > Show Map

ANSWER: New Jersey 1.9%

Geographies

List tab> County > state New Jersey>All counties in New Jersey> Add to your selections> Close overlay> select P4

Modify Table

Transpose rows/columns

Use sort button in Descending order

Answer: Hudson County
