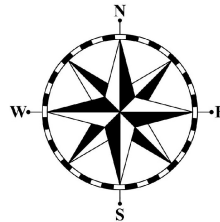

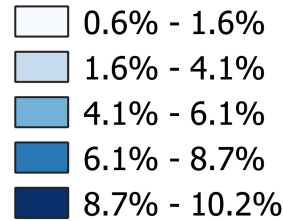

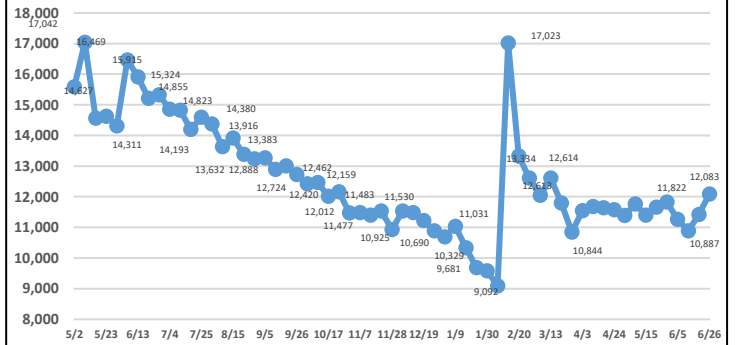

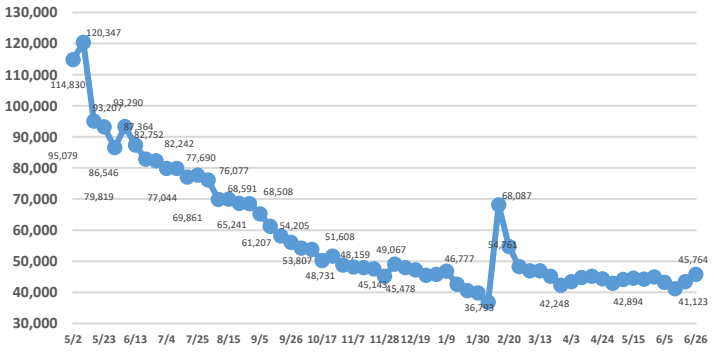
Professional & Business Services Continued Claims



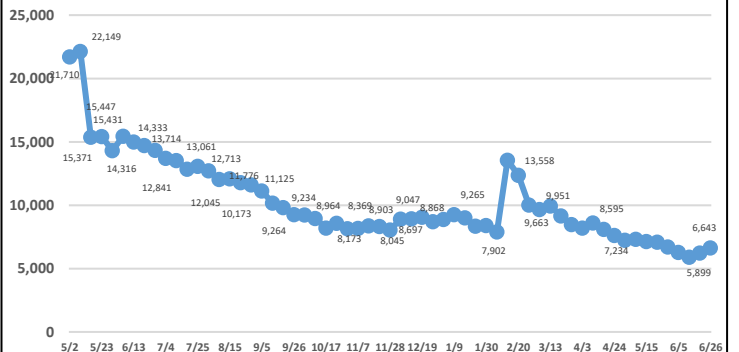
Financial Activities Continued Claims



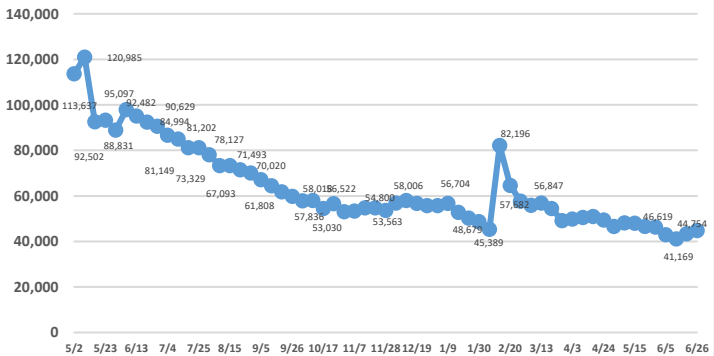
Education & Health Services Continued Claims



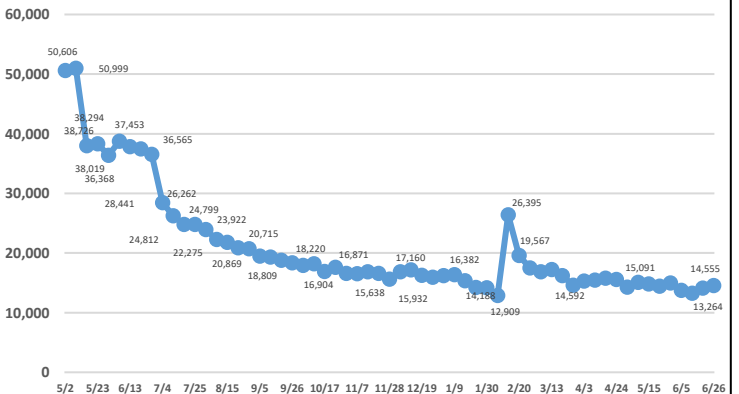

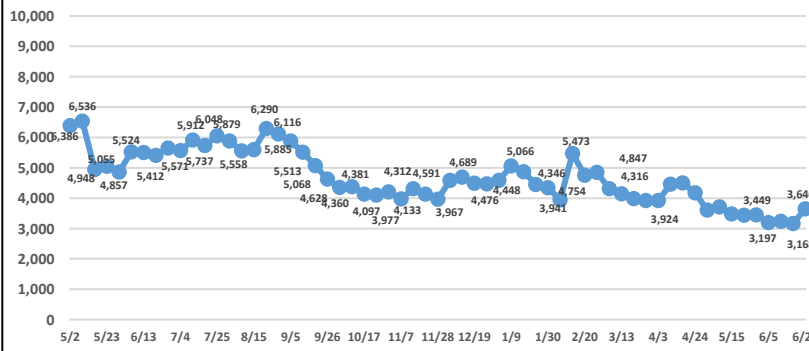
